Online learners summary: We ended the year with four 8th graders enrolled in Edmentum. Three of the four required extensions through June in order to complete the courses. We ended the year with nine SLO students. All but one have met mastery on all outcomes. One of the students that returned to in person instruction in April will need to retake math next year; however, she has met mastery on all other content outcomes.
