

APPLICATION FOR FSL TRAVEL GRANTS

DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE:

The Full Spectrum Learning Travel Grant is intended to support conference and travel costs for those who are presenting their digital pedagogy to a wider audience. If you have been an active participant in one or more of the FSL grants (including course redesign grants, mini grants, the explore or implementation stipend, or other) and are ready to share your good work with others at a conference, this grant can help make that happen.

ELIGIBILITY:

All faculty and staff who teach in some capacity are welcome to apply for funding. Conferences are broadly defined and there are no exclusions for specific kinds of conferences or conferences held in specific geographic locations.

A funding pool of \$3,000 is available. Applications received are reviewed on a first come first served basis. Applications may receive a maximum of \$1000 per year. Proposals may be submitted throughout the year.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

1. Proposals should be submitted using the [FSL Travel Grant Application Form](#).
2. Proposals may be submitted throughout the year.

Submitted applications will be reviewed by a 4-member committee, consisting of: one representative each from Faculty Development, Mulva Library, Academic Technology and Full Spectrum Learning.

3. Project reporting: Upon completion of the conference, grant awardees must submit a conference program as evidence of their presentation being accepted.
