Responsible Implementation of Members Directives

WHEREAS the Green Party of Ontario is a provincial political party with the mission and purpose of electing Green Party of Ontario representatives to the Ontario legislature;

WHEREAS the Green Party of Ontario must thrive with limited financial resources;

WHEREAS the Green Party of Ontario must thrive with limited human resources;

WHEREAS members directives do not always estimate the amount of resources (human or financial) required to implement the directive accurately;

THEREFORE be it resolved that the following be added to Bylaw L of the Green Party of Ontario Bylaws:

In circumstances where The Provincial Executive believes implementation of a members directive would required so many party resources that the implementation would harm the party's ability to meet its political or other goals, The Provincial Executive shall modify the members directive so that it does not negatively affect the party's ability o to meet its political or other goals, including not implementing the directive.
