


## Techo Empathy Activity

### Lesson: [Watch intro video to SDGs](#)

Students will be asked to connect the scenarios of TECHO communities (below) to one of the SDG's (Goals 1-13, 16) which will be posted on the board. Once all the scenarios are posted, students will be given post-its to IMAGINE, write and post what it would feel like to experience that scenario.

**Remind students that their words and body language reflect their empathy for the community we will be working in.**
