Motivation for claiming subsidy for Authored Books/Chapters in books

The DHET requires a written motivation by the **author of the chapter (if individual chapters are being claimed)** or the **general editor (if the entire authored book is being claimed)** not exceeding 500 words, explaining the contribution that the book makes to scholarship, describing the methodology used as well as the unique contribution made to knowledge production. It should be clear that the book disseminates **original research and new developments** within the specific discipline. Declaration must be made to the fact that no part of the work was plagiarized or published elsewhere. The target audience must be stated.
