## 6th Graders

- **This year the class is for both 5th and 6th graders!**
- Prepare them for salvation (later establish them as healthy new believers).
- SAT YP: **NOT for 5th graders.** For 6th graders, before baptism, no need to rush ; case by case
  - It is okay for them to participate in singing (dinner, too). But to avoid them receiving premature spiritual knowledge, in principle, we do not want them to be in the message part. Therefore, the parents may need to pick them up earlier after singing if to bring them to SAT YP.
- LD Table: **NOT for 5th graders.** For 6th graders, once a month before baptism (when combined ; parents with them)
- Own LD class.

- **No separate LD class.** Serving ones serve them person by person (instead of meeting by meeting) beyond the meetings and some in the meetings (LD is the “lab time”).

### The idea:

- At least two serving ones for each YP. Both should coordinate and find time/way to feed the young people in the daily life. At least one of them should be available in the English-speaking meeting with the young person to usher them gradually into the participation & enjoyment & functioning.

- For example, maybe following the rotation of the assigned prophesying group, if serving one 1's group is assigned to prophesy, then serving one 1 should help the young person to prophesy. That is, just treat them like young/new ones to be perfected.
