The Big Point: I Am Wonderfully Made by God!

God's Word: Fearfully and Wonderfully Made (Psalm 139: 13-18)

Huddle Guide Duration: 20 mins

Before Sunday:

- *Pray* and prepare yourself by reading through this Huddle Guide and the Word Write-up for the week found on the HopeKids Service Plan Blogspot.
- Know the Programme Flow for Children's Day 2025: Out of This World!
- Note: Huddle Time is to connect with the children and reinforce the Gospel. Please exercise
 discernment if the kids in your group are already clear of the gospel, then take the time to
 connect and talk to them! You also don't have to go through everything in the Huddle
 Guide!
- Know that you need the following:
 - TO PREP: Where's Everybody Going Gospel Tract
 - o Gift: Gachapon Machine Coin Token
- TO PREP from service rooms / storage:
 - Where's Everybody Going Gospel Tract

Before Service on Sunday Morning:

 Prepare all the items you will need into the stationery boxes so that it is easy for you to access during huddle time.

Activity #1: Welcome, Sharing and Bonding in Circle Time

Objective: To connect with the kids

No Materials Needed

- Have the kids sit in a circle.
- Hello HopeKids! Welcome to Huddle Time. In HopeKids, we always have Huddle time small group time so that we can get to know you better!
- My name is _____ and I will be your teacher for today! Let's go one round to share your name. If it's your first time here today, we really want to get to know you and welcome you here to HopeKids!
 - Give a warm welcome to new kids, but be sure not to make them feel overwhelmed!
- Some simple rules for Huddle Time remind the children that BEST rules still apply: (Especially for Rule B and E)
 - B Before You Speak, Raise Your Hands
 - E Exercise Attention
 - S Silence when Whistle is Blown
 - T Time-Out After Three Taps

Alright, today we learnt that we are all wonderfully made by God! The Bible tells us that how God made each and every one of us is amazing and wonderful. With lots of care and love!

And God made each of you to be unique. No matter how similar you may be to someone, even your siblings or even twins... you're uniquely you. God made you wonderfully to be uniquely you. Let's find out some fun things that make us special. Remember, everyone's answer is special — there's no right or wrong!

Ice Breaker #1: Which would you rather?

We are going to have a very quick ice breaker game. You are going to choose between 1 out of 2 options of what you prefer / rather do. If it's 1, you just need to put up one finger. If it's 2 or the second choice, you put up 2 fingers.

Note: You can choose to come up with your own choices for the children.

- Would you rather eat chocolate or vanilla ice cream?
- Would you rather swim in a pool or climb a mountain?
- Would you rather read a book or play soccer?
- Would you rather winter or summer / cold or hot /rainy or sunny weather?
- Would you rather eat rice or noodles?

In all our preferences, we're different — and that's completely alright! God made you with different

preferences!

Ice Breaker #2: Share One Thing About Yourself!

Now, let's find something special about each person! I'll give you a fun question — just share one thing that's true for you.

Note: Choose from these safe, light prompts. Huddle Leaders can be the first to share too! Huddle leaders don't have to go through all. Just pick 1 or 2 to share.

- What's something you really enjoy doing?
- What's one food you could eat every day?
- What's something you're good at or learning to do?
- What's something that makes you laugh?
- What's something special about your family or culture?
- What's your favourite show / music?
- What's a place you'd love to visit?
- Share one unique thing about yourself!

Alright, thank you so much for sharing. Truly, you're all wonderfully made by God and God made no mistakes. There are times when we may feel small about ourselves, but know this, God makes no mistakes and He made you wonderfully with care and love. And because He made you, He loves you. God wants to be with you forever! And we can all go near to God. Let's now listen to this story!

Activity #2: Where's Everybody Going Gospel Tract

Objective: To share the gospel with the kids

Materials Needed:

Where's Everybody Going Gospel Tract



Take the plastic sheet and place it on top of the picture and move it from side to side to make it move.

- Where's everybody going?
- Let's read this story to find out where these children are going.



- Have you ever wondered who made the earth spin?
- It's God! God made the world and everything in it: the sun, moon, stars and the earth.



- Have you ever wondered who filled the land and sea with plans and animals?
- Yes, you guessed it. It was God! God filled the earth with plants and animals.



- God made the earth and everything in it.
- God made us too and He loves us very much!
- Like what we learnt today, we are all wonderfully made by God.
- The most special thing he created was us!



- Because God is the one who made us, He really loves us!
- And God really, really wants to be with us.
- But sin separates us from God.
- Sin is anything we do that makes God unhappy.
 - Telling lies, fighting and stealing are all examples of sin.
- All of us have sin, and the punishment of our sins is that we can't be with God. We are separated from God, who is perfectly good.



- But because God really loves us and wants to be with us, God sent His son, Jesus to bring us back to Him.
- Jesus came to earth and He was a man who was different from any other person.
- Jesus is God Himself, who came as the son, to take the punishment of our sins.
- Instead of us being punished, he took our place. He died on the cross so that our sins can be forgiven.
- And on the third day, Jesus became alive again, showing how He truly is from God and the son of God with the power to save us!



- Because of Jesus, we don't have to be separated from God anymore.
- Everybody who believes in Jesus will have our sins forgiven and can be with God!
- We can now have a relationship with God.
 - We can become children of God
 - We can call God our Father
- We can one day be with God in heaven.
 - Heaven is a wonderful place
 - There is no sickness, no pain and no hunger
 - No one ever dies
 - Everyone is perfectly happy
- God wants all of us to go to Him. But heaven is not a place we can
 just run to. There's only one way we can be with God in heaven, and
 that is to believe in what Jesus did for us on the cross.



- And here's how you can be with God forever and ever in heaven:
 - 1. Admit that you have sinned and ask God to forgive you.
 - 2. Believe that Jesus died on the cross to be punished instead of you.
 - 3. Invite Jesus into your life to help you turn away from sin!

This might be your first time hearing this, or maybe you have heard it so many times! But maybe today, you feel something in your heart. That is God speaking to you and helping you to know that He is real! He wants you to know that He has won over sin and death and He has the power to save you. Do you want to believe in Jesus?

Let's pray together:

Dear Jesus, thank you for loving me. I know that I have sinned. I have done things that are wrong. I believe that you died on the cross to make things right and good again. I am sorry for all my sins. Please forgive all of my sins and make my heart clean. Please come into my life and help me to know you more and more. In Jesus' Name, Amen

Activity 3: Gift Giving
