

Pre-K - 8 Grade Counseling Program

- **Individual Counseling**
 - 1 on 1 meeting with the counselor to provide academic, social and emotional support for students
- **Small Group Counseling**
 - Counselor meets with small groups of students to address a variety of skills and needs in academic and social and emotional support
- **Classroom Guidance Lessons**
 - We utilize the CharacterStrong Program.
 - Students in grades K-8 receive weekly lessons from counselor and classroom teacher
- **Behavioral and Academic Support + PBIS (positive behavior intervention system)**
 - **IEP- Individualized Educational Plans**
 - A legally binding document identifying academic and behavioral needs and supports for students beyond the general education classroom.
 - Eligibility determined through work with local education agency (Grantwood & Marion Independent School District)
 - **Section 504 Plans-**
 - A legally binding document put in place to provide accommodations within the general education classroom for students with a mental or physical impairment that substantially limits the individual in one or more major life activities
 - Eligibility determined through a team involving counselor, teacher, parent, student, etc.
