1. Call to Order

Chair Jana Pfeiffer called the meeting to order at approximately 9:54 AM.

2. Opening Prayer

Offered by guest Chad Pfeiffer.

3. Roll Call

- Attendees identified themselves as Members, Allies, or Guests via sign-in sheet or Zoom login.
- Membership confirmed for Isaac Casados, Duane Duffy, and Dillon Shije (paid on August 10, 2025).

4. Approval of Agenda

- Motion to approve by Laurie Weahkee | Seconded by Ashley Sarracino
- Motion passed unanimously

5. New Business

A. Financial Documentation & Reporting

- Chair Pfeiffer addressed the need for an amended financial filing by September 2025 due
 to discrepancies between NADCNM's bank account and the campaign finance report
 submitted to the State of New Mexico.
- Requested by Ann Barudin, the item pertains to unresolved financial documentation from approximately 2020–2022.
- **Isaac Casados**, former NADCNM Chair, former DPNM Secretary, 2025 NA SCC member, explained:
 - o Receipts from that period were submitted during a successful DPNM audit.

- Treasurer Lyle Lomayma, who resigned during that time, may not have filed the receipts.
- Songtree Pioche also underwent a similar audit.

• Chair Pfieffer reported:

- Mr. Anastacio Trujillo (Secretary of State Campaign Finance Office) advised that an itemized Excel spreadsheet of contributions and expenses must be submitted as an amendment.
- The original submission lacked this breakdown.
- Upon former Treasurer Lomayma's resignation, financial reporting responsibility fell to then-Chair Isaac Casados.
- As former Treasurer (2023–2025), Chair Pfeiffer emphasized the need for external accounting support.
- o Treasurer Touchine has business experience, but a forensic review may be necessary.
- Estimated discrepancy: \$2,500-\$3,600
- Vice Chair Laurie Weahkee noted the meeting was already near meeting closure, therefore proposed the following action steps:
 - Jana Pfeiffer, Tammie Touchine, and Isaac Casados to contact Rayellen (former DPNM Treasurer) to clarify what receipts/reports were submitted for 2020–2022.
 - o Tammie Touchine to request a formal receipt report from DPNM.
 - If receipts are incomplete, Tammie Touchine to seek guidance from DPNM by September 12, 2025.

Unanimously approved the above action steps to move forward with the agenda.

B. SCC Native American Members - Discussion, Related Matters, and Vote

- Chair Pfeiffer explained:
 - SCC members serve as the governing body of DPNM.
 - o Concerns were raised about the selection process for NA SCC members.
 - On April 8, 2025, the NADCNM NA SCC Selection Committee voted to appoint 14 members.
 - The process did not align with NADCNM Bylaws or DPNM Rules and violated principles of transparency, accountability, and member engagement.
 - NADCNM officers recommended redoing the selection process.

- Ashley Sarracino, former 2023 NA SCC member and former DPNM Chair of Cibola County, presented the letter dated August 1, 2025 **, outlining concerns:
 - o DPNM rules link SCC membership to NADCNM membership requirements.
 - o No formal "call for nominations" was issued, preventing self-nomination.
 - o Inaccuracies in congressional district representation.
 - Five selection committee members voted for themselves.
 - Requested documentation verifying tribal governor consultation.
 - Nominee vetting was unclear (membership, residency, registration).
 - General membership was not informed of the process.
 - Stated she would have declined her previous NA SCC member nomination had she known these details.
 - o August 1, 20251letter co-signed by Aleta Suazo and Beck Touchin.

Additional Input and Reactions

- Vice Chair Laurie Weahkee noted that
 - New letters had been received from Isaac Casados, Duane Duffy, and Michele Montoya, Navajo Nation Vice President **
 - Leadership agreed for these individuals to present their perspectives.
- Isaac Casados, former NADCNM Chair and current Chair of the DPNM Rules Committee:
 - Emphasized his role in developing the NA SCC proposal began in 2019.
 - Stated the intent was to engage tribal leadership and honor sovereignty
 - Cited DPNM Rule 1.2.8: NADCNM does not have authority to remove NA SCC members.
 - Warned that doing so could harm relationships with tribal nations.
 - Recruitment began in November 2024 with consultation from tribal leaders.
 - Nominations received from Pueblos, Mescalero Apache Tribe, and Navajo Nation (excluding Ft. Sill Apache).

- Announced intent to recommend removing NA SCC selection from NADCNM's purview.
- Clarified that NA SCC members are not required to be dues-paying caucus members.
- Noted proposal was drafted before redistricting and gender balance was achieved.

- **Duane Duffy,** Vice President of Mescalero Apache Tribe and 2025 NA SCC Member:
 - Expressed disappointment that the process was being questioned.
 - Stated he was fully consulted and believes NADCNM lacks authority to dismiss tribal representatives.
 - Emphasized that Mescalero Apache Tribe followed the process and made a nomination.
 - Urged that concerns be addressed for future appointments, not retroactively.
 - See attached letter dated *
- Dillon Shije, former NADCNM Chair and current Pueblo of Zia Councilman and 2025 NA SCC Member:
 - Supported Isaac's account and emphasized tribal sovereignty.
 - Confirmed nominations were solicited from tribal leaders and he was nominated by his governor.
 - o Indicated a letter would be forthcoming from the Zia Pueblo Governor.
 - Named selection committee members and confirmed motion to approve nominees was passed.
 - Shared document titled "Minutes for the NADCNM Selection Committee to Approve the 14 Native SCC Members for 2025–2027." ***
- Michele Pauline Abeyta, State Representative and 2025 NA SCC Member:
 - Highlighted the importance of representing satellite communities like the Navajo community in Alamo, NM.
 - o Acknowledged the process may be imperfect and offered to help refine rules.
 - Expressed interest in youth recruitment but voiced concern due to current turmoil.
 - Stated there was no "behind-the-scenes" involvement in her selection and accepted the role to serve the community.
- Brenda Hoskie, Secretary of DPNM and Chair of the DPNM Rules Committee:

- Noted that other caucuses face challenges and are expected to resolve issues internally before escalating to the Judicial Council.
- Recommended that Isaac Casados recuse himself due to potential conflict of interest.
- Requested clarification on whether SCC members must be paid caucus members.
- Mentioned that prominent Democratic leaders had recommended individuals who were not selected.
- Noted that the Navajo Nation President's office reported no record of being contacted for nominations.

Laurie Weahkee:

- Expressed appreciation for current NA SCC members and their willingness to serve
- Proposed tabling the vote to allow NADCNM leadership to consult with DPNM and clarify the SCC process.

Brent Deltsoi:

- Objected to tabling the vote.
- Suggested that dissatisfaction with selected members was driving objections.
- Argued that the process should not be invalidated.

Jana Pfieffer:

- Reiterated that the issue centers on procedural integrity and alignment between NADCNM Bylaws and DPNM Rules.
- Emphasized NADCNM's commitment to transparency, accountability, and its broader mission: voter rights and registration, advocacy issues and statewide membership growth.
- Meeting Notification & Document Access (though raised earlier, included here for clarity):
 - Some members noted receiving meeting details and documents late on August 9. Chair Pfieffer confirmed initial notice was sent August 1 with a document link, and a reminder on August 9 added location info. Tech issues prevented Zoom document sharing. Chair Pfieffer had offered to assist with printed copies.

Motion and Vote

Laurie Weahkee amended her motion to table the vote, allowing NADCNM leadership time to consult with DPNM and review all points raised. The amendment proposed rescheduling the vote to a Business Meeting on Thursday, August 28th, at 5:30 PM. The amendment was accepted as friendly.
