

Fire up the Cricuts!

For the crafty Barbie-loving Jays fan, I have a fun idea. We have dozens of “Hi Vladdy!” signs that pop out of the crowd during the game. They are just small banners, but I think it’s a fun and joyful thing that we can do together. Also, I just love signs. I’m planning on making a bunch and handing them out before the game. So if you’re making one, you may as well make a few!

Inspiration:  Barbie The Movie | Hi, Barbie!

Supplies required for two “Hi Vladdy!” signs:

- White vinyl (12 x 12 ”)
 - Hot pink bristol board from Dollarama
 - Blue bristol board from Dollarama
 - 12 x 24” mat
 - Application tape for the text onto the pink shadow
1. Cut down the hot pink bristol board to a 12 x 24 “.
 2. Cut the blue bristol board into 2 6” strips (6 x 22 “)
 3. Pencil in some guides for the lettering on the blue bristol board. 5 cm on the sides, 2.5 cm from the bottom.
 4. Use [this template](#) to cut the letters from the white vinyl and the shadow in the pink bristol board.
 5. Use your application tape to put the text onto the shadow.
 6. Line up the outer edges of “Hi” and “Vladdy!” to the 5 cm guides on the side, 2.5 cm guide on the bottom.
 7. Glue firmly into place.
 8. Spread the Vladdy and Barbie joy!
