1. Virginia Bluebells, *Mertensia virginica*

- Blooms: March- April Height: 1.5 to 2 ft Spread: 1 to 1.5 ft
- Blue blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: **Part shade to full shade** Attracts: Bumble bees and butterflies
- Tolerates rabbits, black walnut

2. Wild Sweet William, *Phlox divaricata*

- Blooms: April - May Height: 0.75 to 1 ft Spread: 0.75 to 1 ft
- Rose/lavender/ Violet/blue blossoms, showy, fragrant flowers
- Sunlight: **Part shade to full shade** Water: Medium
- Attracts: Hummingbirds, butterflies Tolerates Deer, drought, clay soil, dry soil

3. Wood Lily, *Trillium cuneatum*

- Blooms: April – May Height: 1 to 1.5 ft Spread: 0.75 – 1 ft
- Maroon to yellow to orange to reddish green blossoms, fragrant flower
- Sunlight: **Part shade to full shade** Water: Medium
- Attracts: Moths Tolerates: Heavy shade

4. Sweet White Violet, *Viola blanda* *** Keystone plant

- Blooms: April – May Height: 0.25 to 0.5 ft Spread: 0.75 to 1 ft
- White blossoms Water: Medium to Wet
- Sunlight: **Part shade** Attracts: butterflies
- Tolerates: Deer

5. Indian Pink, *Spigelia marilandica*

- Blooms: May Height: 1 to 2 ft Spread: 0.5 to 1.5 ft
- Red and yellow blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: **Part Shade to full shade** Attracts: hummingbirds
- Tolerates: Wet soil

6. Strawberry bush, *Euonymus americanus*

- Blooms: May -June Height: 4 to 6 ft Spread: 4 to 6 ft
- Greenish yellow blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: **Part Shade** Attracts: Birds
- Tolerates: Clay soil, black walnut

7. Bunchberry, *Cornus canadensis*

- Blooms: May -July
 - White blossoms
 - Sunlight: **Part Shade**
 - Tolerates: Rabbits, deer
- Height: 0.25 to 0.75 ft Spread: 0.5 to 1 ft
Water: Medium
Attracts: butterflies, birds
Good leaf color in fall

8. **Foam Flower**, *Tiarella cordifolia*

- Blooms: May -July
 - White or pink blossoms
 - Sunlight: **Part Shade to full shade**
 - Tolerates: Rabbits, deer
- Height: 0.75 to 1 ft Spread: 1 to 2 ft
Good fall color
Water: Medium

9. **Sunflower**, *Helianthus divaricatus* *** Keystone Plant

- Blooms: July-September
 - Yellow rays with darker yellow center disk blossoms
 - Sunlight: **Part Shade**
 - Attracts: Birds, butterflies
- Height: 2 to 6 ft Spread 1 to 3 ft
Water: Dry to Medium
Tolerates: Deer, Drought

10. **Common Dittany**, *Cunila origanoides*

- Blooms: July to September
 - Lavender blossoms, fragrant leaf
 - Sunlight: **Full sun to Part Shade**
 - Tolerate: Drought, Dry Soil, Shallow-Rocky Soil
- Height: 0.75 to 1.5 ft Spread: 0.75 to 1.5 ft
Water: Dry to Medium
Attracts: butterflies, showy flower

11. **Turtlehead**, *Chelone glabra*

- Blooms: August- September
 - White blossoms
 - Sunlight: **Part shade**
 - Tolerate: Erosion, Wet Soil
- Height: 2 to 3 ft Spread: 1.5 to 2.5 ft
Water: Medium - Wet
Attracts: Butterflies

12. **White Wood Aster**, *Eurybia divaricata* *** Keystone Plant

- Blooms: August- September
 - White with yellow to red centers blossoms
 - Sunlight: **Part shade to full shade**
 - Attracts: Butterflies
- Height: 1 to 2.5 ft Spread: 1.5 to 2.5 ft.
Water: Dry to Medium
Tolerates Heavy shade

1. Moss Phlox, *Phlox subulate*

- Blooms: March- May Height: 0.25-to-.5-ft Spread: 1 to 2 ft
- White to purple blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: butterflies
- Tolerates: deer, drought, erosion, and air pollution

2. Beardtongue, *Penstemon digitalis*

- Blooms: April-June Height: 3 to 5 ft Spread: 1.5 to 2 ft
- White blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: Hummingbirds, butterflies
- Tolerates: Deer and drought, clay soil, dry soil

3. Lupine, *Lupinus × hybrida*

- Blooms: May-July Height: 3 to 4 ft Spread: 1 to 1.5 ft
- White, red, pink, yellow, blue, purple or bicolor blossoms
- Sunlight: **Full sun** Water: Medium
- Attracts: butterflies Tolerates: rabbits and deer

4. Rose Verbena, *Glandularia canadensis*

- Blooms: June- August Height: 0.5 to 1.5 ft Spread: 1 to 2 ft
- Rose-pink to Rose-purple blossoms
- Sunlight: **Full sun** Water: Dry to medium
- Attracts: butterflies Tolerates: drought, dry soil, shallow-rocky soil

5. Butterfly Weed, *Asclepias tuberosa*

- Blooms: June- August Height: 1 to 2.5 ft Spread: 1 to 1.5 ft
- Yellow, orange blossoms Water: Dry to medium
- Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: butterflies
- Tolerates: deer and drought

6. Obedient Plant, *Physostegia virginiana*

- Blooms: June- September Height: 3 to 4 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft
- Pink, white blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: hummingbirds
- Tolerates: deer

7. Rattlesnake Master, *Eryngium yuccifolium*

- Blooms: June- September Height: 4 to 5 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft

- Greenish white blossoms
 - Sunlight: **Full sun**
 - Tolerates: Drought, Erosion, Clay Soil, Dry Soil, Shallow-Rocky Soil

8. Yarrow, *Achillea millefolium* 'Paprika'

- Blooms: June - September
- Dusty Red blossoms
- Sunlight: **Full sun**
- Tolerates: Deer, drought, dry soil

Height: 1.5 to 2 ft Spread: 1.5 to 2 ft
Water: Dry to Medium
Attracts: Butterflies

9. Blazing Star, *Liatris spicata*

- Blooms: July- August
- Red purple blossoms
- Sunlight: **Full sun**
- Tolerates: Drought and clay soil

Height: 2 to 4 ft Spread: 0.75 to 1.5 ft
Water: Medium
Attracts: Birds and butterflies

10. Swamp Milkweed, *Asclepias incarnata*

- Blooms: July- September
- White, pink, mauve blossoms
- Sunlight: **Full sun**
- Tolerates: Deer, Clay Soil, Wet Soil

Height: 3 to 4 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft
Water: Medium to wet
Attracts: Butterflies

11. Swamp Mallow, *Hibiscus moscheutos*

- Blooms: July- September
- White to pink blossoms
- Sunlight: **Full sun**
- Tolerates: wet soil

Height: 3 to 7 ft Spread: 2 to 4 ft
Water: Medium to wet
Attracts: Butterflies

12. Goldenrod, *Solidago speciosa* ***

- Blooms: July- September
- White blossoms
- Sunlight: **Full sun**
- Tolerates: Deer, drought, clay soil

Height: 2 to 3 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft
Water: Medium
Attracts: Butterflies

13. Tickseed, *Coreopsis tripteris*

- Blooms: July- October

Height: 2 to 8 ft Spread: 2 to 8 ft

- Brown disks w/yellow rays Water: Dry to medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: Butterflies
 - Tolerates: Deer, drought, clay soil, dry soil, shallow-rocky soil

14. Blue Sage, *Salvia azurea*

- Blooms: July- October Height: 3 to 5 ft Spread: 2 to 4 ft
 - Azure blossoms Water: Dry to medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: Butterflies
 - Tolerates: Deer, Drought, Dry Soil, Shallow-Rocky Soil

15. False Aster, *Boltonia asteroides* var. *latisquama* 'Snowbank'

- Blooms: August - September Height: 3 to 4 ft Spread: 3 to 4 ft
 - Yellow blossoms Water: Dry to Medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: Hummingbirds, Butterflies
 - Tolerates: Deer, Drought, Clay Soil, Dry Soil, Shallow-Rocky Soil, Black Walnut

16. Aromatic Aster, *Symphyotrichum oblongifolium*

- Blue and Purple blossoms Height: 1 to 3 ft Spread: 1 to 3 ft
 - Blooms: August - September Water: Dry to Medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: Hummingbirds, Butterflies
 - Tolerates: Drought, Erosion, Clay Soil, Dry Soil, Shallow-Rocky Soil

17. New England Aster, *Symphyotrichum novae-angliae*

- Deep pink purple blossoms Height: 3 to 6 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft
 - Blooms: August - September Water: Medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: Butterflies
 - Tolerates: Clay Soil

18. Blazing Star, *Liatris aspera*

- Blooms: August - October Height: 2 to 3 ft Spread: 1 to 1.5 ft
 - Purple blossoms Water: Medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun** Attracts: Birds, Hummingbirds, Butterflies
 - Tolerate: Drought, Erosion, Dry Soil, Shallow-Rocky Soil

1. Columbine, *Aquilegia canadensis*

- Blooms: April-May Height: 2 to 3 ft Spread: 1 to 1.5 ft

- Light pink/yellow to blood red/yellow blossoms
 - Sunlight: **Full sun to part shade** Water: Medium
 - Attracts: hummingbirds Tolerates: rabbit, deer, drought, dry soil

2. Wild Geranium, *Geranium maculatum*

- Blooms: April-May Height: 1.5 to 2 ft Spread: 1 to 1.5 ft
 - Pale pink, deep pink, lilac blossoms
 - Sunlight: **Full sun to part shade** Water: Medium
 - Attracts: Butterflies Tolerates: deer, rabbits, drought, dry soil

3. Strawberry, *Fragaria virginiana* * Keystone Plant**

- Blooms: April-May Height: 0.25-to-.75-ft Spread: 1 to 2 ft
 - White blossoms and edible fruit Water: Medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun to part shade** Attracts: birds and butterflies
 - Tolerates: deer, drought, and erosion

4. Pussytoes, *Antennaria neglecta*

- Blooms: April-June Height: 0.5 to 1 ft Spread: 0.5 to 1 ft
 - White blossoms Water: Dry to medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun to part shade** Attracts: butterflies
 - Tolerates: drought and dry soil

5. Blue Violet, *Viola sororia* ***

- Blooms: April-August Height: 0.5 to 0.75 ft Spread: 0.5 to 0.75 ft
 - White to purple blossoms Water: Medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun to part shade** Attracts: Butterflies
 - Tolerates: deer, clay soil and black walnut

6. Bee Balm, *Monarda bradburiana*

- Blooms: May Height: 1 to 2 ft Spread: 1 to 2 ft
 - Pink to white w/purple blossoms Water: Dry to medium
 - Sunlight: **Full sun to part shade** Attracts: butterflies, hummingbirds
 - Tolerate: deer, drought, dry soil, shallow-rocky soil

7. Yellow wild indigo, *Baptisia sphaerocarpa* 'Screamin' Yellow'

- Blooms: April -May Height: 2 to 3 ft Spread: 2 to 5 ft
- Yellow blossoms Water: Dry to medium
- Sunlight: **Full sun to part shade** Attracts: butterflies

- Tolerates: drought and dry soil

8. Blue False Indigo, *Baptisia australis*

- Blooms: May- June Height: 3 to 4 ft Spread: 3 to 4 ft
- Indigo blue blossoms Water: Dry to medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: butterflies
- Tolerates: rabbits and drought

9. Eastern Bluestar, *Amsonia tabernaemontana*

- Blooms: May- June Height: 2 to 3 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft
- Blue blossoms, good fall leaf color Water: Medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: hummingbirds, moths
- Tolerates: deer, drought

10. Wild Pink, *Silene caroliniana*

- Blooms: May- June Height: 0.75 to 1 ft Spread: 0 .75 to 1 ft
- Purple blossoms Water: Dry to medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: butterflies
- Tolerates: drought, shallow rocky soil

11. Golden Alexander, *Zizia aurea*

- Blooms: May- June Height: 1.5 to 3 ft Spread: 1.5 to 3 ft
- Yellow blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: butterflies
- Tolerates: N/A – Can be used in rain gardens

12. Blue-eyed grass, *Sisyrinchium angustifolium*

- Blooms: May- June Height: 1.5 to 2 ft Spread: .5 to 1 ft
- Blue blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: Bees, bumble bees
- Tolerates: N/A

13. Hairy Woodmint, *Blephilia hirsuta*

- Blooms: May -September Height: 1 to 2.5 ft Spread: 0.75 to 1.5 ft
- Blue and purple blossoms, fragrant flower, showy leaf
- Sunlight: Full Sun to **Part Shade** Water: Medium
- Attracts: Endangered Rusty Patched Bumble bee Tolerates: Deer

14. Purple Coneflower, *Echinacea purpurea*

- Blooms: June- August Height: 2 to 5 ft Spread: 1.5 to 2 ft
- Purple blossoms Water: Dry to medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part sun
- Attracts: butterflies & birds Tolerates: deer and drought, shallow-rocky soil

15. Whorled Milkweed, *Asclepias verticillata*

- Blooms: June- September Height: 1 to 2.5 ft Spread: 1 to 2 ft
- White blossoms Water: Dry to Medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to Part Shade Attracts: Butterflies, hummingbirds
- Tolerates: Deer, drought, dry soil

16. Black-eyed Susan, *Rudbeckia hirta*

- Blooms: June- September Height: 2 to 3 ft Spread: 1 to 2 ft
- Yellow to orange-yellow rays & dark brown centers
- Sunlight: Full sun to part sun Water: Medium
- Attracts: butterflies Tolerates: deer, drought, clay soil

17. Evening Primrose, *Oenothera biennis*

- Blooms: June- September Height: 3 to 5 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft
- Yellow blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part sun Attracts: butterflies and birds
- Tolerates: drought

- Blooms: June - September Height: 3 to 6 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft
- Deep Red blossoms Water: Medium to Wet
- Sunlight: Full sun to Part shade Attracts: Hummingbirds and butterflies
- Tolerates: Deer and wet soil

- Blooms: July-September Height: 1 to 3 ft Spread: 1 to 3 ft
- Pink blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: Butterflies
- Tolerates: Drought

- Blooms: July-September Height: 2 to 4 ft Spread: 2 to 3 ft

- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: Butterflies
- Tolerates: Deer, drought, clay soil

- Lavender-pink blossoms Water: Medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: Butterflies, Hummingbirds
- Tolerates: Deer, clay soil, black walnut

22. Cardinal flower, *Lobelia cardinalis*

- Blooms: July- September Height: 2 to 4 ft Spread: 1 to 2 ft
- Scarlet red, white or rose blossoms Water: Medium to wet
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts: Butterflies, Hummingbirds
- Tolerates: Rabbit, deer, wet soil

23. Alum Root, *Heuchera villosa* 'Autumn Bride'

- Blooms: Aug-Sept. Height: 1.5 to 2 ft Spread: 1.5 to 3 ft
- White blossoms, Showy flower Water: Medium
- Sunlight: Full sun to part shade Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies and bees
- Tolerates: N/A
