Overview about what makes our league unique

1. **Futsal Rules & Referees**

All matches are played with official futsal rules. We provide the most experienced futsal referees in Western Michigan, ensuring that every game is officiated at a high standard.

2. **Cost + Scheduling**

Forget the hassle of booking courts or arranging referees for games. For less than the cost of 2 futsal tournaments (6 games), Ginga provides 10-12 games to all teams (venue & ref fees included!)

3. **Team Placement**

We strive for balanced competition by going above and beyond what most tournaments and leagues do for placement. Our league's unique seeding game system provides the most balanced divisions possible for all teams.

4. **Championship Weekend**

Our championship weekend wraps up the season on a high note, with the top four teams in each divisions participating in a single elimination semifinal/final bracket at our brand new location, Limitless Arena.

WHAT'S NEW THIS YEAR

1) SEEDING GAMES (NOV–DEC)

Three official seeding games before winter break.

- Ensures balanced, competitive divisions
- Reduces blowouts during regular season competition
- Creates meaningful matchups from Day 1

Division schedules will be finalized after seeding play, allowing coaches till mid-December to submit coaching conflicts for Jan-Feb (regular season)

2) PLAYOFF TOURNAMENT

- Top 4 teams in each division qualify to playoff tournament
- Tournament will take place at Limitless Arena, with semifinals/finals format.
- Players cannot participate in playoffs if they have not played in at least half the regular season matches (not “stacking” teams with guest players to win a chip!)

3) TROPHIES, MEDALS, AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME MVPS

- Ginga league will award champion trophy and medals
- Ginga league will award finalist medals
- Ginga league will award a Championship Game MVP Trophy

4) ROSTER & CHECK-IN SYSTEM

To protect competitive integrity:

- Official roster submission required
- Proof of age required
- Game-day check-in process
- No ineligible guest players

Clear standards. Fair competition. No exceptions.

5) COLLABORATIVE DIVISION BUILDING

- Clubs with 10+ teams in the league will have direct input in division placement discussions.
- We believe in building divisions with the community, not in isolation.

6) PROFESSIONAL LEAGUE OPERATIONS

- Improved scheduling process
- Clear communication timelines
- Stronger competitive structure
- Championship-focused environment

7) SEASON STRUCTURE SNAPSHOT

November–December

- Seeding Games (3). Based on the registration information provided by each team, we will assign 3 seeding games against various opponents. Results will help assess each team's competitive level for division placement.

January–February

- Division Play (7 games). The goal is for 8-team divisions playing each opponent only once. • •
- Divisions could have as few as 5 teams, in which case teams will play home/away vs. 3 opponents and once vs. the fourth opponent.

Championship Weekend (Feb 27-28, 2027)

- Top 4 teams play semifinal games (1v4, 2v3) at Limitless Arena on Court A
- Teams move immediately to the Championship Court to play the Championship Game.

REGISTRATION DETAILS

If you'd like to discuss a club partnership with Ginga League (10 or more teams), please let us know. Instead of posting high prices and giving most teams "discounts", we are going with a transparent pricing structure to keep costs low for all teams and benefit the growth of futsal in West Michigan. **The current projected League fee is \$950 per team, which includes all costs. For a team of 10 players, that's less than \$10 per game.**
