

Judge George Thomas  
Associate Judge, Austin Municipal Court

Born in New York City to Indian immigrants, and raised in Houston, Judge Thomas graduated from Trinity University in 1998 with a B.S. in Biology and a B.A. in History. He then earned his law degree from the University of Houston Law Center in 2002. After graduating, he worked as a Legislative Assistant in the Texas House of Representatives and practiced immigration law in Houston.

Moving to Austin in 2004, he became a criminal prosecutor for the City of Austin, and then later for the Travis County Attorney's Office. After nearly a decade of criminal prosecution, he was appointed as a Judge to the Municipal Court of the City of Austin.

He is the first Indian-American judge in Travis County history, and one of only a handful in the state. Judge Thomas has been active in a variety of local civic, political, and professional organizations locally and nationally.
