Our building has two main spaces: A large gathering space perfect for hosting workshops and a separate play space perfect for kids (can be closed off with see-through glass doors) while adults convene. 6-Week Weeknight Workshop Space User Sliding Scale \$75-\$150 per session (\$450-\$900 total)*

- Choose a consistent weeknight time (Monday-Friday) to host your workshop or gathering, subject to availability
- Set up can begin as early as 6:30pm, and clean up/exit is by 9:30pm
- Manage your own clean up (tidy bathrooms, wipe down tables, take out garbage)

6-Week Weekend Workshop Space Use: Sliding Scale

\$150-\$250 per session (\$900-\$1500 total)*

- Choose a consistent weekend (Saturday-Sunday) 2-hour block of time to host your workshop or gathering, subject to availability
 - We'll gladly add 30 minutes to either side for set up/clean up, upon request
- AM Workshops begin and end before noon
- PM Workshops begin after 1pm and end before 9:30pm
- Manage your own clean up (tidy bathrooms, wipe down tables, take out garbage)

*Sliding scale fees are negotiable, especially for organizations doing aligned work! Please reach out to Hannah at <u>hello@thedandelionproject.us</u> to learn more!

Amenities available:

- a comfortable and creative gathering space with a large couch and floor cushions
- table and chair seating for up to 32 + 4 kitchen stools at the island
- a full kitchen with fridge, stove, oven, microwave, coffee pot, tea kettle, and more
- a maker space with tables and a whiteboard
- a science corner with microscopes and more
- a play area with building blocks, cars, dinosaurs, and more
 - Note: play space can be closed off from the gathering space, so kids can play while adults convene
- a private room with seating area (we call it the "treehouse")
- young adult and childrens' books
- two (2) all gender restrooms
