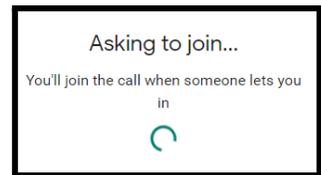


# **GOOGLE MEET** For Student Enrollment Conferences

The Lee's Summit R-7 School District is utilizing Google Meet for Student Enrollment Conferences. Contained within this guide, you will find best practices for [Google Meet](#) that can help you to connect quickly and easily with your child(ren)'s teacher(s).

**Note:** Teachers will be using a feature of Google Meet which will require you to “ask to join” the conference. If a teacher already has a conference in progress, you may have to wait a short time before being allowed to enter the meeting.



## Choose your Device



**Computer/Laptop:** For best results, please use a supported operating system (macOS, Microsoft Windows, or Chrome OS) running the current version of any of the following web-browsers: Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Edge, or Apple Safari.



**Smartphone/Tablet:** Depending on your mobile device, you can download and use Google Meet's mobile app from the [Apple App Store](#) or [Google Play Store](#).

## Join A [Google Meet](#) (requires a Google Account)



**From Your Student's Google Account:** You can login to your student's Chromebook using their LSR-7 credentials to join a Google Meet. You can find your student's login credentials in [PowerSchool](#) under the **Student Credentials** tab.

Once you have logged in, navigate to <http://meet.google.com>. You can join a Meet by clicking the **+Join or start a meeting** button and entering the Meeting Code provided by eScheduler.



**From Your Personal Google Account:** You can access [Google Meet](#) by logging into your personal account. When prompted, please enter the Meet access code provided by eScheduler and select **Join**.

**By Phone:** If you would prefer to join by phone, please dial the **telephone number** and **PIN** provided by eScheduler. Should you experience technical difficulties during a video call, use the phone number and PIN to connect to a conference.
