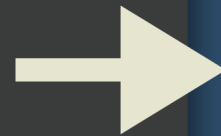

WEEK THREE STATUS REPORT

H.R. 262 Rep. Wheeler

This bill amended HR 237 to cut out a monthly \$40,000 expense. Vetoed by Gov. Key.*



H.R. 263 Rep. Wheeler

This bill repeals H.R. 255, which would have funded state-wide replacement of lightbulbs.



H.R. 264 Rep. Dimmick

This bill recognizes K9 units as government employees. Passed 09/19 - 4/0 supermajority. Good K9s!



*A veto overturn vote was held on Sept. 25; 4-1



WEEK THREE STATUS REPORT

H.R. 265 Rep. Finch

This bill amends the criminal code to properly list ectasy in our penal code. 5-0, on Key's desk.



H.R. 266 Rep. Lawson

This bill rewrites copyright laws in the state to reduce red tape and reward artists. 5-0, on Key's desk.



H.R. 270 Rep. Dimmick

Pay changed to adjust PW wages, add support extra services for departments. Open for public feedback.
