

Unfinished Business

- I. Damali Tolson | Director of Student Life
 - A. Dinetta and I have been hunting down the mystery of feminine hygiene products on campus. We made a breakthrough today! Forty-one dispensers were donated from CUNY with just enough products to fill them once. The problem is, we also need disposable containers in 198 stalls. That is what they need funding for, they can cover the funding of having the product. We are waiting for a quote, so this could be one of the bigger USG initiatives. It is a one time purchase, but there needs to be a dispenser in the actual stall or there is nowhere to put the actual products in. We will get back to you all with a quote for the cost, they have the dispensers and should be able to cover the actual products.


- a) Abdullah Mahdi | EVP: We might not be able to begin this process until next semester, but once we have a quote we could go to BOD and ask for more money from the surplus to support this purchase as we do not have enough from our budget to do so.
- 2. Jason Martinez | Representative Senator: Does this purchase have to be renewed every year?
 - a) Damali: If you were asked to cover the product itself, you would have to renew this initiative each year. Since the school is willing to cover the product itself, the installation of the disposal tins would be a one time fee so it wouldn't have to go to each USG. It would just be installed once by your purchase and Facilities would proceed to fund product supplies from then on.
- 3. Adelaide Ilyasov | VP of Academic Affairs: I spoke to Stephen about the idea to donate the money raised by the Student vs. Faculty event to the Food Pantry to supply them with menstrual products. I just want to confirm that this would be allowed.
 - a) Dinetta Curtis | Deputy Director of Student Life: The money can go to the Food Pantry, though I don't know if it would make sense for it to be donated for menstrual products since the college is going to cover that. If that is what you would want the money to do, then we would just need to figure out how the money is utilized or how it's earmarked on that end.
 - b) Damali: I think it might be a good idea to give it to the Food Pantry because it is one thing to have the products on campus, but that doesn't mean everyone has access to them at home. If we are allowed, we can do it, we just have to find out.
