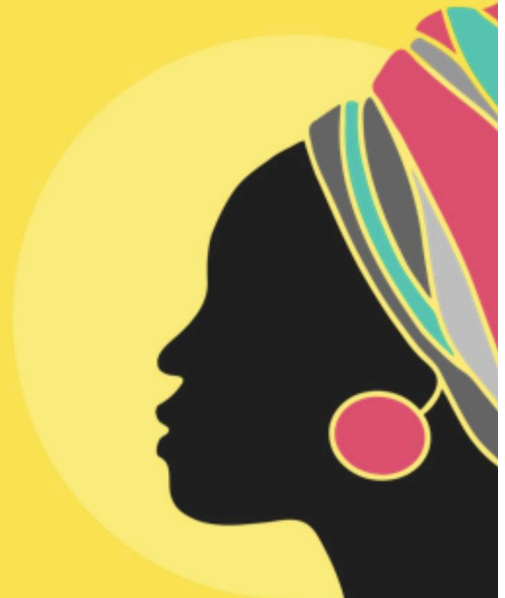


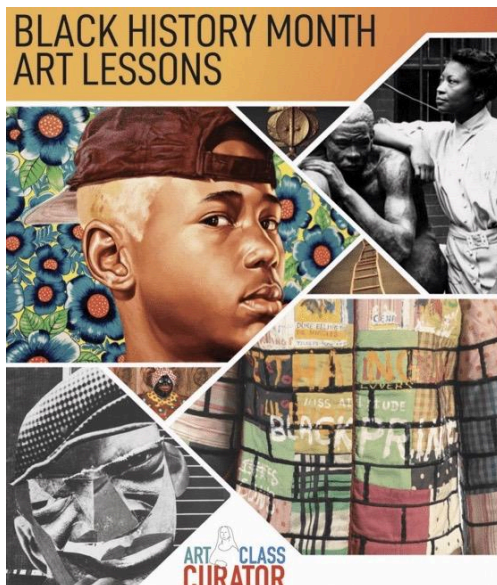
# Black History Month resources
