# Mission objectives

Arthur Ryan: The Final Trial

**Start:** 4th of May 3311, 12.00 UTC

**Start system:** The Capital of Exologic **HIP 78345**

**Designated carrier:** [EX0] Exologic Alpha (G3T-NTQ)

Following the success of the LAMBDA Expedition and the discovery of Arthur Ryan's lost ship, the Ryan Family Foundation proudly launches its next great mission:

**Destination:** Dryman's Point

**Target Sector:** Thaimeou

**Objective:** To follow Arthur Ryan's final route and find lost Fleet Carrier

**Why It Matters:** This region is the last stop of Arthur Ryan expedition.

Our journey is an **excellent** school for new commanders. And if you can, we'll just have fun. Whether you're a seasoned explorer or a new recruit, this journey is about more than discovery — it's about legacy. Join us as we follow the final trail of Arthur Ryan. You can earn a lot of money doing exobiology as well!

We have two research projects in progress. You can help us to collect data for them and still have a lot of money from exobiology.

**Mission is financed from private funds of the Ryan Family. All costs of tritium are covered. There is no need to mine tritium during the whole trip.**

# What we know about Arthur Ryan:

This is our 5th big expedition since we found the last journal from Arthur Ryan – great explorer and our ancestor. But this will be the last one and most important.

Everyone can join. Even if you are a new explorer. We will teach you everything.

WHAT WE FOUND on our past expeditions:

## 1. ELLIPSE TRIP

The first major EXO expedition, aimed at exploration and education. The route led through Colonia, Sagittarius A\*, and numerous previously undiscovered systems.

### Connection to Arthur Ryan:

During this journey, we encountered our first clues about Arthur Ryan's disappearance — a damaged SRV was found containing fragments of a journal entry. The entry suggested Arthur had ventured toward Beagle Point and possibly the Formidine Rift, sparking deeper interest in his mysterious expedition.

## 2. ARCADIA UNVEILED: BEYOND TO BEAGLE POINT

The second large EXO mission, focusing on establishing and exploring Arcadia (Lyaiso YW-B b13-5) — EXO's remote base of operations. The expedition also visited Beagle Point and Sagittarius A\*.

### Connection to Arthur Ryan:

Near the Beagle Point, we discovered an old lost ship and personal computer with a heavily encoded message.

## 3. EXPEDITION NOSTROMO

A smaller, focused investigation intended to trace possible remnants of Arthur Ryan's fleet.

### Connection to Arthur Ryan:

In a Hawking's Gap Region, we recovered a SRV containing a damaged data chip. Forensic analysis showed it originated from the era of Arthur's Dream and contained partial coordinates along with references to Arthur's waypoint in The Veil region.

## 4. EXPEDITION LAMBDA

A breakthrough expedition where we finally discovered Arthur Ryan's lost ship.

### **Connection to Arthur Ryan:**

Using the recovered chip from Nostromo, we accessed onboard systems of the derelict carrier and extracted Arthur Ryan's full expedition plan from 3200, titled "The Path to Raxxla."

It outlined the complete route: Formidine Rift, Errant Marches, Colonia, The Conduit, Beagle Point, The Veils, and ultimately Dryman's Point, with the Thaimeo sector named as the final destination. This document validated the course of the next expedition and solidified Arthur Ryan's legendary path.

### **SUMMARY:**

Each EXO expedition gradually brought us closer to the truth behind Arthur Ryan's fate. Starting with fragments in Ellipse Trip, through encoded transmissions in Arcadia Unveiled, and critical data from Nostromo, we reached the pivotal discovery in Expedition Lambda: his lost ship and his final trail. Now, with the route in our hands, we prepare for the next and most important journey — into Dryman's Point, to follow Arthur Ryan: The Final Trail.

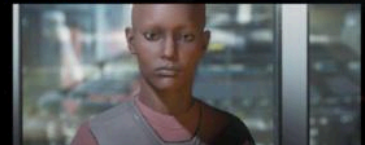

# Waypoints

## START (4.05) HIP 78345

*We will take a group photo at the main deck of Exologic Alpha. Short briefing for the start of the journey.*

1. **(5-7.05)** Plaa Aec IZ-N c20-1 - *Project Dynasty abandoned settlements*
2. **(8-10.05)** Grie Hypue RS-U e2-0 - *Exploration days*
3. **(11.05)** Thaimeou HE-G b38-0 - *Our destination point*

We stay at our destination point as long as needed to find the Arthur Ryan Fleet Carrier. If it takes longer than two weeks we will provide transport between Dryman's Point and the Bubble.

### ***Details:***

#### Waypoint 1. Project Dynasty

This will be our first stop. This is the secret exploration initiative created in the year 3270, by organisation "The Club". It was preparation for finding the place with ELW to escape before the next Thargoid War. It doesn't go as planned.

We need to check four places and collect data for our scientist:

Alpha Settlement: Plaa Aec IZ-N c20-1

Beta Settlement: Plaa Aec XZ-Z b41-0

Gamma Settlement: Plaa Aec TT-B b41-3

Delta Settlement: Plaa Aec RY-B b41-1

# Attractions

## SRV races

Completely unprofessional, crazy and spontaneous side activity. Form of escape from tedious looking for exofauna. We have this habit of someone screaming: "the first person in one piece on the other side of this crater wins!". Except that there are no prizes.

## Dogfights

One rule: pulse lasers only, but you can choose between gimballed and standard versions. And only in Haulers. Ok, nerd, make it two rules.

## Ships races

Run Forrest, run behind the planet. Land there at indicated coordinates and go back to the Carrier as fast as possible.

## Plant Eater competition

You have an SVR, you have a bio scanner, and you need to find three samples of a particular plant. The faster one wins.

At the end of the journey we will make the Hall of Fame of our trip. We will honour individual achievements:

1. For the system with most bodies (*screenshot proof*)
2. Total profit for organic data\*
3. For the highest amount of first footfalls\*
4. Side activity winners

# Preparations

1. Add our carriers to the bookmarks in Galaxy Map
2. Make a screenshot of the exploration stats from codex and send to CMDR MichaelRyan at discord. (If you want to take a part of The Hall of Fame at the end of the journey).
3. Make sure you don't have illegal stuff, bounties, fees or notoriety.
4. Take your favourite pet on the board
5. If you have an idea for the research, send a brief outline of the study. You can do it while travelling too.
6. Take your favourite ship, outfit, suit, but remember you can buy everything on the Carrier without additional fees.
7. Take materials for engineers and engineering. Especially data and manufactured materials.
8. If you want to collect RAW materials in an easy way, buy a flak launcher, missile rack and/or mines launcher.
9. Send your med data to our medical stuff to make sure they can take care of you if you need it. Exploration can be a little dangerous.

# Trivias

- We take with us around 15 000 T of tritium worth almost 1 B Cr
- Our main carrier travelled more than 263.000 light years
- Exologic Alpha did almost 800 jumps
- You can take 40 ships with yourself to our carrier
- At least 50 ships were sold by our main fleet carrier due the previous expeditions.
- Ships and modules in our shop weight 15 148 T
- Carrier needs 130 T of tritium per jump

# Insurance

## Help and rescue

Although insurance is not included, that doesn't mean you are exposed to the risk on our journey.

Our team can help you if you have troubles in your research mission. We can help to bring you back to our carrier with our refuelling and repair staff. Just let us know you need help.

**Rescue Agent:** CMDR vGhost

If you need to go back to the Bubble (last visited station to be precise) you can still use our very safe Escape Pods. You can find them near the bridge at the Fleet Carrier. Remember about selling your discoveries data before that.
