In case anyone missed it last week, the calendar for the fall is attached again! Here are some important things to note:

- 1) All weekday rehearsals are on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6PM-9PM. Please be sure to arrive beforehand so that we can start on time at 6.
- 2) Weekend Competitions:
 - Competitions begin on Saturday 9/11 with Rainbow of Stars at Eastridge. **ALL competitions are mandatory.**
 - Rehearsal times are provided for all Saturday competitions, these times are approximate and may be adjusted slightly as we approach these dates.
 - The start time of the competition is also provided, this is not when we perform, but when the actual show starts. More info will be provided as we approach these dates.
- 3) Halftime performances are included on the calendar, attendance at these performances is mandatory. Please note that for Homecoming on 9/25, we march in the Homecoming parade in the morning and perform at the halftime show in the afternoon. More info will be provided as we approach these dates.
- 4) Championship weekend – we will rehearse on Saturday 10/30 in preparation for the Championships on Sunday 10/31. This weekend is extremely important for all members and their families!
