

# Healy Townhall Q&A Jan. 27th

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| Can students bring a water bottle to drink throughout the day?   | YES. Students are allowed to bring their own water bottle as long as they are not breakable and they are safe  |
| What percentage of the day are students logged into a class to learn with a teacher who is teaching remotely?  | 180 Min of synchronous instruction - about 50% of the day- the teacher will explain further in a letter sent to parents January 29th   |
| Does certain grades have to enter the school from specific entrances, or does it not matter?   | YES. Your child's teachers will be reaching out to you with more specific information about this.  |
| Can students bring their own laptop for usage during the school day?   | NO. Students will be supplied with school issued laptops for daily use.  |
| Who's teaching them remotely?  | Information is forthcoming and will differ by teacher  |
| Who's teaching them remotely when they can't enter the building?   | Students will be instructed by their same teacher both remotely or in-person   |
| Do students bring their own supplies such as notebooks, markers, pens etc  | YES. Students have the option of bringing their own supplies or they may use the supplies issued by their teacher. Students will not be able to share supplies with each other   |
| What are kids supposed to do when they walk and do not have a parent to drop them off at school? What is the expected wait time once dropped off, getting screened and entering the building? Are the parking logistics planned out? | The first week will be our test week although we are hoping to ensure that students make it in the building no later than 8 am it is our ultimate goal to have students in the building and ready to learn at 7:45am<br>Parking logistics will be the same |
| Should students be bringing their own headphones?  | YES. Students may bring their own headphones however, the school will also have headphones available for student use   |
| Will we leave our books at school, or do we have to carry them everyday?   | It depends on what the teacher is assigning; students do not need to take  |

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|   | everything back and forth on a daily basis unless the student needs those particular items   |
| If there are siblings - how do they screen with a parent at different entry locations?  | As long as you have filled out screening for both students, you need not be concerned about having to be at two entries at once.   |
| How many days do students attend in-person learning at school per week? 4   | Monday<br>Tuesday<br>Thursday<br>Friday  |
| For students in gifted, if the teacher is teaching remotely, who will be supporting students in-person?                           | The teacher will teach all students in the remote setting and other support staff at Healy will supervise those students while instruction is going on   |
| Can a student go to school 2 days (Mon, Tue) and do remote learning Wed, Thur, Fri?   | NO. All students must choose either in-person or hybrid learning due to scheduling and instructional preparation considerations  |
| So EVERYONE is remote on Wednesday? No students in the building?  | YES. All students will engage in remote learning every Wednesday. Your teacher will share their schedule   |
| Are uniforms required?  | YES: k-6th grades - should wear navy pants and powder blue shirt<br>6th-8th grades should wear tan pants and navy shirt  |
| Who do I contact to opt out from in-person learning?  | You may call the main office.  |
| On Friday, when we get student schedules we will know for sure then if their teacher is going to be in-person or remote, correct? | YES. Teachers will be in contact with students and parents to provide this information as well as more information about their schedules   |
| Just to clear if we don't like the way it's going the first week we can go back to remote learning full time right?               | YES. However, if you are currently remote, you may not opt into in-person learning until the 4th quarter. In addition, if you decide to go to from in-person to hybrid, you may not come back to in-person until quarter 4 |

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| <p>Will the day be similar to this week's schedule? (Week of Jan 25)</p>   | <p>NO. This week was modified for the teacher to return and engage in planning to welcome the student's return. This was a special schedule only for that week</p>   |
| <p>Does it mean that in April all students are required to go back to school?</p>  | <p>NO. We do not have this information at this time</p>  |
| <p>Support services: Is that happening remotely or not?</p>  | <p>It depends on the ADA accommodations of staff and whether or not the student is in-person or not. What we do know is that all students that require services will get them as needed. If the service provider has an accommodation to stay remotely, the student will receive services remotely</p> |
| <p>Can the students wear their own mask?</p>   | <p>YES- the district is also providing each student with 3 reusable cloth face masks</p>   |
| <p>Are there any graduation plans?</p>   | <p>We are still awaiting guidance from CPS around graduation</p>   |
| <p>NWEA and selective enrollment - Will you be able to take the NWEA for selective enrollment at the end of the year?</p>                    | <p>We are still awaiting guidance from CPS</p>   |
| <p>If there is no in person on Monday possibly more days next week will they still have school or is there no school until a resolution?</p> | <p>There should still be remote learning but watch the news for more information and direction</p>   |
| <p>Will children with IEP be only with their general education teacher or will they be getting help from their pullout teacher as well?</p>  | <p>Students with IEPs will follow their normal schedule.</p>   |
