### MACKINAC ISLAND PUBLIC SCHOOL IS ON THE BALLOT.

The proposal **does not** represent a new tax but the renewal and restoration of the existing operational millage.

The millage doesn't apply to taxpayers who live in their primary residence and passage won't cost you a dime more than you already pay.



#### What is proposed on May 6th?

Voters are asked to consider renewing the three-year non-homestead operating millage that expired in 2024. It is a 7.8-mill tax levy on business and rental properties in our school district. It is not a new tax on primary residences or other exempt properties.



#### What is a non-homestead operating millage?

It is a tax levied only on non-homestead property, which includes all taxable property other than one's principal residence and certain other property classifications. **It is not a tax on owner occupied homes.** This operating millage, by law, funds Mackinac Island Schools' day-to-day operations and programs.



### *What is the impact on MIPS if the renewal doesn't pass?*

Mackinac Island Public Schools will **lose more than \$2.3 million annually** which **accounts for approx. 70%** of the district's revenues, used for staffing, equipment, classroom supplies and the operation of our school buildings. A loss of that magnitude would lead to **major funding changes and significant cuts in staff, academic programs, transportation, athletics and facilities.**

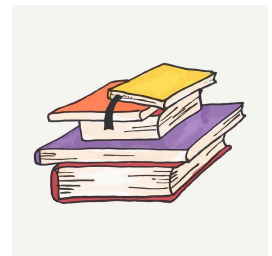
