Title:	School Site Councils
Approved:	July 13, 2026

A district site council shall be established representing each district building. The district site council shall be responsible for providing advice and counsel for evaluating state, school district, and school site performance goals and objectives and in recommending methods that may be employed at the school site to meet these goals and objectives. Discussions may include allocations of the school budget and administrative and management functions.

Membership of the district site council shall include, at a minimum, each building principal, and representatives of: teachers and other school personnel, parents of pupils attending the school, the business community, and community leaders.

The principal shall recommend district site council members for superintendent approval.

The district shall establish meetings that shall be subject to board approval and make recommendations and proposals to the board.
