

Section 13 Confidentiality of Personally Identifiable Information

The school student records of a child with disabilities shall be maintained confidentially in accordance with the requirements of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, the Illinois School Student Records Act, the Illinois School Code, the Illinois Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Confidentiality Act, the Illinois Domestic Violence Act of 1986, and their respective implementing regulations. All information maintained concerning a student receiving special education is directly related to the provision of services to that child. For information regarding the types of personally identifiable information concerning all students, including students with disabilities, that is collected, the maintenance period, persons to whom the information may be available, and under what circumstances the information may be disclosed, see the following School District policies and procedures: Board Policy 7:340 - Student Records.
