- 4700 TRUCK WAS SHOWING ABS WARNING LIGHTS AND THIS HAD TO BE ADDRESS WITH NEW SENSORS AND COMPUTER SCAN RESET FROM PETRO SERVICE.
- SEVERAL LOADS OF COLD PATCH HAS BEEN APPLIED THROUGHOUT THE VILLAGE. MOSTLY MAPLE ST. /GREEN ST./MAIN ST.
- THE MOWERS HAVE BEEN SERVICED FOR UPCOMING SEASON
- THE BALANCE OF OUR ANNUAL SALT PURCHASE WAS RECEIVED AND THIS WAS LOADED AND PUSHED BACK INTO THE SALT BOX
 - ESTIMATED APPROX. 300 TON IN THE LARGE BOX
- THE SMALL SALT BOX IS FULL OF SALT WITH THE SCHOOLS FINAL BALANCE.
 - THE SCHOOL HAS APPROX. 185 TONES IN THIS SMALLER BOX AND ITS ENTIRETY IS THE SCHOOLS SHARE.
- THE ONE TON TRUCK HAS BEEN SUFFERING FOR SEVERAL YEARS OF ELECTRICAL ISSUES WHEN USING THE PLOW. WE HAVE BEEN SEEKING HELP FOR SEVERAL YEARS. FINALLY THE SOLUTION FROM CLASSIC CHEVY IS THAT A SECOND BATTERY SHOULD HAVE BEEN INSTALLED AND TWO SPECIAL HARNESSSES FOR ELECTRICAL LOADS WERE NEEDED.
