

THE ELO IS BASED ON COMPETENCIES THAT GUIDE A STUDENT'S LEARNING AND TRANSLATE THE LEARNING INTO CREDIT.

The Credit Bearing ELO should:

- Describe competencies that illustrate what the student should know and be able to do.
- Be considered for elective credit.
- Be standards based experiences.
- Consider interdisciplinary competencies.
- Include college and career readiness standards.

Helpful Hint: Consider developing an experiences that is an extension of prior/current learning; or, develop an experience in an area not in the Program of Studies.

To Do: Work with your counselor and Extended Learning Coordinator to develop the experience.

ELO Process: The ELO experience is part of your four year journey/plan and can serve as an entry point to post graduation plans.
