Where can I get more information about Webster Athletics?

How do I sign up?

All forms need to be filled out prior to the first day of practice in order to participate.

1. Athletics Online forms

Fill out all the necessary forms through Skyward including participation agreement, concussion, and release. Here is a link for instructions on how to sign up.

2. Physical card

A <u>physical card</u> must be filled out with a doctor's signature and uploaded through Skyward. Physicals are good for 2 years. An <u>alternate year card</u> is required for the following year. The physical card only needs to be uploaded once for the entire school year.

3. \$25 fee per sport

The athletic fee should be paid through Skyward. If you are participating in 2 or more sports, there is an individual cap of \$50. There is also a family cap of \$100

What sports are offered at Webster?

There will be an information meeting for each sport during lunch prior to the start of each sport. At this time, students will pick up a handout with more details regarding the upcoming season and a practice/competition schedule will be distributed if available at the meeting as well.

Important Information about Webster Athletics.....

- All students who go out for a sport make a team, there are no cuts. Boys basketball and girls volleyball have "A" and "B" teams that are determined on skill level.
- Practices and competitions are held primarily on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and
 Fridays. Occasionally there may be a special event scheduled on a Saturday.
- Students must be passing all classes at the end of the quarter when grades come out. If a student receives a failing grade, he or she is ineligible to participate in games for 15 days.

- Webster is a member of the Braveland Conference. There is a north, central, and a west division within this. We compete primarily against schools within our own division (north).
 Occasionally, we compete against a school in the west division or a school outside of our conference. Divisions are determined by geographical location. Directions to away games and track and cross country meets can be found on the Webster Athletics website.
