<u>Part I:</u> Digital Citizenship (modeled by all members of the Kennedy community)

A successful experience in our remote learning will require teamwork, patience, growth mindset, and, most importantly, a demonstration of our Kennedy core values (Impact, Relationships, and Innovation).

We know that parents have a lot on their plate! At the same time, we always want to ensure that our children and all learning community members are safe. Thus, we ask you to spend some time with children reinforcing the critical tenants of digital citizenship that we will be using at the Kennedy School this year and reviewing in all classrooms.

- I will keep myself SAFE on the Internet /I will tell an adult if an online conversation or action makes me feel unsafe.
- I will keep my information PRIVATE and SECURE.
- I will be a POSITIVE, CONTRIBUTING member of our online community.
- I will COMMUNICATE respectfully and treat classmates and teachers with respect. **
- I will give CREDIT to others for their work. My work will ALWAYS be my own.
- I will follow the classroom rules of each teacher.

Guiding Principles for Remote Learning

- 1. Students should be dressed.
- 2. Students should be on mute unless called upon or otherwise stated by the teacher.
- 3. Students should be present and engaged.
- 4. Students are encouraged to participate using video, however we understand that not all students may feel comfortable doing so.
- 5. Students should be sitting upright and ready to learn.

District and School Attendance Messages:

- 1. **Attendance:** Systems are in place to track daily attendance. All students are expected to attend and engage in synchronous and asynchronous activities designed by their teachers for the full school day. Click here for additional details.
- 2. Parents/Guardians need to inform the school if their child is absent by reporting absences at <u>617-629-5440</u>. Failure to report will result in a call home from the Redirect Teacher to ensure your child's safety.
- 3. Whenever possible, please schedule non-emergency appointments after school (2:35 pm) or during school vacations.

School Remote Learning Guidelines:

- 4. Students should be present and engaged in their learning activities. We encourage students to use all available ways to participate in the lesson if they choose to keep their video off, such as verbal participation, the chat feature, or reaction buttons."

Fresh breakfast and lunch will be available following the posted menu (<u>www.somerville.k12.ma.us/fns</u>). Parents or students can pick up free meals; no ID is required.

Snacks: Afternoon snacks will be provided by Food & Nutrition Services for students participating in Community Schools and Parks & Recreation after school programming.

Free Enrichment Programming: Community Schools (pre-K and K) and Parks & Recreation (grades 1-8) will be offering free outdoor enrichment programming to provide students with opportunities for safe, social interaction starting September 21st based on their cohort assignment. This programming is weather-dependent. All current health and safety guidelines, including mandatory use of masks and social distancing, will be in place. Based on the interest survey families completed last week, we anticipate that we will have enough space to accommodate all interested families.
