 - Funds provided for the following:
 - General field trip support in the amount of \$400 per classroom, K-6 for a total of \$4800
 - Classroom stipend in the amount of \$8/per student in Gr.1-6 for a total amount of \$2016
 - Financial support for the remaining balance on the Evergreen Theatre Artists in Residency program up to the amount of \$3750 (\$11, 250 covered by grant)
 - Financial partnering for Welcome Back Pancake Breakfast - council has contributed \$1200 towards the total \$2480.63 and will revisit paying the remainder at a later date
 - Financial partnering for Mathletics subscription for Gr. 3-6 up to a total

cost of \$2053.80
