TEACHER EVALUATION

- A. The Sedgwick School Committee believes that the skills of the teaching staff must be evaluated on a regular basis to assure quality instruction for students. Teacher evaluations shall be completed according to a Committee approved teacher evaluation process.
- B. All teachers shall be evaluated by the principal or, in some circumstances, by the superintendent. The evaluations will include a written, narrative evaluation for each teacher with annual goals established by the principal and the teacher.
- C. The principal is responsible for implementation of the evaluation process and for oversight of the progress of the teacher evaluations.
- D. The Special Services Director shall assist with the evaluation of special education and Title 1A staff by providing information on the technical aspects of their positions.
