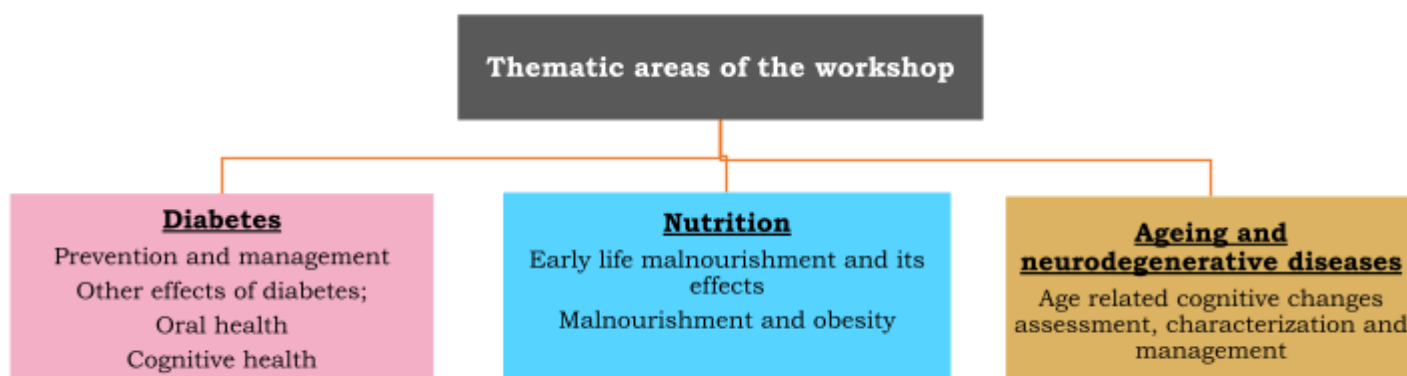
Integrative Research for Health and Disease
