Family shelter in San Francisco, who have a larger same day shelter system. It is available only for families under 18 who are enrolled in the SF school system and pregnant women. Breakfast, dinner and mats are provided during the stay.

Shelter in San Francisco specifically for women(with or without children) who are facing domestic violence. They provide emergency shelter, counseling, and educational resources on preventing DV among teens.

Oasis Family Shelter

Family shelter located in San Francisco. They don't have any designated entrance points or waitlists. For families in need of emergency placements for a maximum of 14 days, it offers some beds available for self-referral. For families in need of an emergency shelter placement, the program provides ten beds. In case that all of the beds are taken, the 14-Day Emergency Placement team will call the family again when a bed becomes available after placing their name on a callback waitlist. As part of this program, homeless individuals staying the night in emergency shelters receive intensive case management. In-depth case management and support services, including drug abuse treatment, employment counseling, and housing searches for the long-term homeless, are provided by them in a variety of ways. Phone is run and managed 24/7.

Shelter in Richmond for families, men, women and children. Currently has 195 shelter beds for homeless single women and women with children. Of those, 30 beds are for emergency shelter and 165 beds are for long-term discipleship program. They also provide case management, food pantry and a life transformation program.

GRIP Family Housing Program

Family shelter in Richmond, provides emergency shelter and transitional housing for families with children. Offers private family rooms, 3 meals per day, mailing address, telephone/voicemail access, housing advocacy, vocational assistance, referrals to substance abuse and mental health treatment. Minor child must be in the direct care of the adult for shelter placement when offered shelter placement.

Single Adult Shelters (no children)

Single adult shelter for men and women in San Rafael, offers shelter for up to 40 people per night. There are also 32 apartments on the top two floors for permanent supportive housing, a program that includes rental assistance, health and mental health care, and other services for people who have experienced prolonged homelessness. Self referrals are on Mondays starting at 10a-1p only

COTS
