Teaching Between Members

This policy outlines the rules by which OGC members can arrange for private lessons between themselves.

The Policy is intended to:

- Encourage self-organising among members, inspiring greater creative and collaborative opportunities;
- Eliminate the need for the OGC administrative involvement in booking and arranging private lessons between members;
- Provide a cost-effective way for intermediate level glass artists to develop their skills;
- Maintain a safe and high-quality learning environment

Under this policy, members can make their own arrangements for private lessons using the rules outlined below. Please contact the Board for a list of approved instructors.

This policy applies to OGC approved members only. Non-members must arrange private lessons through OGC Administration.

This policy will be reviewed by the Board of Directors no less than once per year.

Rules for Teaching Between Members

- 1. The agreement that members make with each other regarding financial or non-financial payment for services is between them, and at their own risk. OGC is not responsible for financial arrangements between members.
- 2. The agreement that members make with each other regarding teaching content is between them, at their own risk. OGC is not responsible for lesson content or teaching quality.
- 3. The Instructor (teaching) member must be approved by the OGC as a Hot Shop Teacher or Hot Shop Teaching Assistant.
- 4. The student (learning) member must be approved by OGC at the Intermediate or Advanced Level.
- 5. Novice Level members are not eligible to arrange for their own private lessons and must arrange for any private lessons through the OGC Administration or Board.
- 6. There is a maximum limit of two students per instructing member per session.
- 7. Blow slots must be booked and paid for based on the current OGC User Policies.
- 8. Any supplies required for the lesson outside of what is provided as part of the rental slot are the responsibility of the members.
