- Format: Multiple-choice
- Number of questions: 40 questions
- Passing score: 65% (26 marks out of 40)
- Duration: 1 hour

The ITIL 4 Foundation exam is not especially difficult, but some students make it so by thinking they can pass without <u>studying</u>. So, whilst it may seem obvious, our top tip is not to assume you can pass without studying.

One of the main things test-takers struggle with during the ITIL4 Foundation Exam is time management. Most successful candidates complete the exam in between 20 and 40 minutes. If you're taking fewer than 20 minutes to complete the exam, you're increasing the chance that you will misread the questions and therefore reducing your chances of passing. It's obviously okay to use all the available time, but do make sure that, when you are completing mock exams, you are finishing within the one-hour time limit.

Tips to Prepare Efficiently

- Focus on the syllabus. You don't need to read the whole of the ITIL 4
 Foundation eBook cover-to-cover, and realistically, it would be very hard to
 remember all of that. Therefore, we highly recommend reviewing the syllabus
 and focusing your study on the key topics.
- 2. Don't just study for a pass. You should aim to be able to score 80% in both sample papers before you take the certification exam. If you're scoring less than 80%, you need to study more because the pressure of the exam is likely to result in you getting a few questions wrong, so you need to be above the threshold.
- 3. **Memorise key terms and definitions** as they are relatively easy marks that you don't want to miss in the exam. These include:
 - The purpose of the 15 ITIL Practices listed in the syllabus
 - The purpose of the 7 ITIL Principles
- 4. Make sure you understand. Before you can think about answering questions on specifics, you need to ensure you understand the module as a whole. It is far easier to recall information that is understood, rather than simply memorised.
