# New name for a common Foamflower

The flowering plant previously known as Heartleaf Foamflower (*Tiarella cordifolia*) is now called Creeping Foamflower (*Tiarella stolonifera*) in some (but not all) locales. The new name emphasizes the fact that *Tiarella stolonifera* produces a leafy <u>stolon</u> (sometimes called a runner). *Tiarella stolonifera* sends out a creeping stolon after flowering but any given plant may or may not have a stolon (just like it may or may not have a flower). In any case, **all** plants known as *Tiarella stolonifera* have the ability to produce stolons by definition.

The name change has been accepted by <u>POWO</u>, <u>VASCAN</u>, and <u>Flora of the southeastern</u> <u>United States</u> (2022 edition). iNaturalist has supported <u>Tiarella stolonifera</u> since January 2022.

Since *Tiarella stolonifera* was <u>segregated</u> from *Tiarella cordifolia*, the latter name refers to a new taxon confined to the East Coast of the United States from Maryland to Georgia. Since the meaning of *Tiarella cordifolia* has changed, be careful to interpret legacy references correctly. If you see the qualified name *Tiarella cordifolia* <u>sensu stricto</u>, you know the writer is referring to the new taxon. Similarly, *Tiarella cordifolia* sensu lato refers to the old taxon. An unqualified name may refer to either taxon.

## Identification

Three morphological characters are used to distinguish *Tiarella* species: 1) presence or absence of stolons; 2) size and shape of basal leaves; and 3) presence or absence of stem leaves. Both *Tiarella cordifolia* sensu stricto and *Tiarella stolonifera* have similar basal leaves and no stem leaves, but of the two, only the latter can produce a stolon. Since any given plant may or may not have a stolon, distinguishing the two can be very difficult. Altogether there are five species of *Tiarella* in eastern North America (two with stolons), so be careful. There's an identification key in wikipedia that will help distinguish *Tiarella* species.

## Distribution

In eastern North America, at least one species of *Tiarella* occurs in each of 26 provinces and states. Multiple species of *Tiarella* occur in eight (8) states. *Tiarella stolonifera* occurs in 22 provinces and states, but it is the **only** species of *Tiarella* in 17 of those provinces and states (highlighted in color below).

For comparison, *Tiarella cordifolia* sensu stricto occurs in just five (5) states, all of which have at least two species of *Tiarella*. The ranges of *Tiarella cordifolia* sensu stricto and *Tiarella stolonifera* do not significantly overlap but are immediately adjacent along the Blue Ridge Mountains in western Virginia and western North Carolina.
