Dear Farmington Public Schools Families,

Late bus service is now operational for students in grades 5-12. Late bus service is designed to support participation in after-school activities and academic programs.

Please note the following important details regarding this new transportation service:

- General Bus Stops: The late bus routes are not identical to regular
 home-to-school routes. Late buses operate on a condensed schedule with a
 limited number of general area bus stops. Students will be dropped off at a
 designated stop that is the closest and safest option to their home address,
 rather than their usual, specific bus stop.
- Student Responsibility: Students are expected to know which general stop is
 closest to their residence. When boarding the bus, students must inform the
 driver of their general area drop-off location. The driver will only make stops
 within their assigned zone, and areas with no students needing a stop will be
 eliminated from the route to ensure efficiency.
- Parental Communication: We encourage you to discuss the late bus routes with
 your child to ensure they understand their appropriate drop-off point. It is
 important that families make arrangements to meet their child at the general bus
 stop location at the estimated drop-off time. Parents are responsible for the
 safety of their child to and from this general stop.
