Supplies:

brown construction paper
chalk pastels
color wheel

Elements of Art Discussion Questions:

- What colors do you see in the artwork?
- Are they cool or warm colors?
- Are they close to each other on the color wheel?
- What color is the central focus of the artwork?
- What color is used the most? the least?
- Explain what a landscape picture is.
- Discuss the types of plants and animals you would see in the desert? What might you see in the background?
- Explain to the students that chalk pastels may be used on the tip like a crayon but are often used on their sides to better blend colors. They do not need to push hard when drawing.

Lesson Plan:

- Have the students draw a landscape picture of the desert with the chalk pastels on their construction paper. Encourage them to fill their papers with many different types of plants and animals.
