If you've been onboarded either as a local, or national organiser you'll get access to our intranet and resources. Simply visit <u>organise.dsyp.org</u>.

⚠ You'll get an automated email saying you've been added to a Google group. If this hasn't happened, email admin@dsyp.org and we can check your access.

You can also access the shared drive from your Google Drive (under Shared Drives).

You will need to have a Google Account or @gmail.com or @googlemai.coml email address. If you're not sure, keep reading.

I see an error message or 404 error when I access the intranet

This is because you're signed in to multiple Google Accounts. Visit https://tinyurl.com/DSYPOrganise where you can select the Google Account or email address that you used to sign up with us.

⚠ If you create a separate browser profile or browser, stay signed in to just the one Google Account and <u>organise.dsyp.org</u> will work for you without problems.

I don't have a Google Account nor a @gmail.com or @googlemail.com address, help!
