Seguin High School Matador Football FAQs Oct. 19, 2020

Will Seguin High School play football in Matador Stadium this fall?

Yes. Matador Stadium will be complete and the first varsity game is scheduled for Sept. 25. However, scheduling may change at any time due COVID closures or quarantines.

Will capacity be reduced at games?

Yes. Capacity will be limited to 25 percent in accordance with UIL guidelines and Governor Abbott's recommendation. In order to help facilitate this, seats on every other row will be blocked off for proper social distancing.

Do I have to wear a mask at Matador football games?

Yes, attendees will be expected to wear a mask in the stadium.

How will capacity limits and social distancing measures be achieved?

In order to meet requirements, approximately percent of the tickets on each side of Matador Stadium will be sold.

Will there be reserved seating?

All ticket sales will be general admission only.

How can I buy tickets?

Tickets can be purchased online the week of each game at https://www.seguin.k12.tx.us/page/athletics.tickets or at the Seguin Athletic Office. Tickets will go on sale each week from 9 a.m. Tuesday until noon on game day or until sold out. If not sold out by noon on gameday, remaining tickets will be sold at the gate.

My child is participating in the game (football/band/cheer/dance). Is there any way I can get tickets early?

Yes. Parents of student participants (football/band/cheer/dance) will have the opportunity to purchase two general admission tickets starting at 9 a.m. on the Monday of each home game. Participant parents may purchase additional general admission tickets on Tuesday. Participant parents who do not purchase guaranteed tickets from 9 a.m. Monday to 9 a.m. Tuesday will forfeit their guaranteed tickets to general public sales.

Will season ticket packages be honored?

Season ticket holders should contact the Seguin ISD Athletics office at 830-401-8022 for complete details on procedures and options, including the opportunity to refund season tickets through Sept. 11.

Do young students need to be accompanied?

Yes, students in eighth grade and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at varsity football games.

If I leave the stadium, may I return?

No, unless a new ticket is purchased.

Will hand sanitizer be available in the stadium?

Hand sanitizer and/or hand washing stations will be available in all SISD athletic Facilities.

Can I go and socialize with my friends during the game?

For health and safety concerns, spectators must stay in the stands at all times unless using the restroom or visiting the concession stand. No one will be allowed to congregate in common areas. Younger spectators must stay in stands with parents at all times.

Will games be live streamed online?

Yes, varsity home games will be streamed on Facebook Live.

Once the game is over, how long can I hang out in Matador Stadium?

Spectators must leave the facility immediately after the conclusion of the event. Parents should wait outside the facility for athletes.

Will the clear bag policy be in effect?

Yes, only clear bags will be allowed to be taken into the stadium.

Are outside food and drinks allowed?

No. Other than an unopened water bottle, no outside food or drinks will be allowed in the stadium.

Will concession stands be open?

Yes, concessions will be available and open for every game.

Will there be portable restrooms again?

The new Matador Stadium features new restrooms.
