Electric Policy!

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for the rest of YEDA show season **"No one can plug anything into any facility outlet"**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which **must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office. once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase**. Hook up fees vary depending on location and charged per night. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. We hope you will understand that we are not trying to be difficult but we must be respectful of the facilities that we are using and continue to show there for many years. Please pass this information along to your teams. We are looking forward to having great shows that are fun and educational for all our exhibitors.

NRHA Pattern 11



Horses must jog to the center of the arena (see Judges Guide for maneuver description). Horses must walk or stop prior to starting the pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right led complete three circles to the right; the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete three circles to the left; the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large circle to the right, but do not close this circle. Run down the center of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
6. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
7. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Horse List

1. **Andy** (Hancock) - Great draw! Does best if the rein is a little looser, stay out of his face. Ball spurs ok, easy to set up for leads.
2. **Arie**: (Hancock) ranch type will ride best with contact but do not trap. Level appropriate spurs.
3. **Big Shot** - (Timmermann's). Nice easy-going horse. Spring-loaded jog more contact with the reins and set him up for his leads. Big easy looper, soft legs for cues. No spurs or crop.
4. **Blue**: (Marcia) Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
5. **Charlie** (Marcia) - Light bit contact. Dull spurs. Two hand option.
6. **Chester** (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.
7. **Cindi**- (McColley) No spurs, light contact, use voice commands first and very light leg aides.
8. **Dawg** - (Puthoff) Height Limit 5'9" Ball or no ball spur, small horse moderate contact, set up for leads - especially right use leg in corners or circles.
9. **Fred** (KCPH) Weight Limit #160 Walk jog only. Has a spur stop. Can get lazy at times, just use legs and voice. Light hand contact. Has a weight limit as he is elderly.
10. **Gator** (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.
11. **Grinder**- (Marcia) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
12. **Henry** - (Timmermann's) Ranch horse. Spring loaded jog, smooth lope likes leg contact needs to be reminded to collect but good mannered. Spins and does flying lead changes. No spurs.
13. **Holli** (M & M) Appropriate Spurs for level. Feet out to stop (Reiner type) Can get anxious. Stay soft and quiet with her. Use verbal cues ("Whoa" to stop, "Easy" Or Hum to slow down.) Light rein contact. 2 handed option
14. **Hollywood** (Buckeye) - Ball or Rowel spurs, Reiner, Don't override. She may get strong
15. **Homer** (Buckeye) - ball or rowel spurs. Set up for leads. Help him in lead changes and keep forward motion. Steady down to stops with light hand.
16. **Izzy** (Hancock) ranch type let her have a little forward do not over bridle has lead change, may need ball spurs as the day unfolds. Please check with steward throughout the day.
17. **Jerl** -(Circle M) Reiner type, can be used in all divisions he is quiet enough just really bouncy jog. Spurs can be used, easy but can get forward in patterns if not controlled well

18. **Jess Too Temp** (National Champ) - division appropriate spurs. For walk trot use lots of leg! She takes a lot of leg, especially loping off on the right lead. A little bit of an attitude but pretty easy going.
19. **Jess-**(Marcia) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
20. **Jett** (Royal Creek) – BAY GELDING QH - RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
21. **Joker-** (McColley) Medium contact, division appropriate spurs (he’s kind of dull sided). Crop allowed, basic trained. Set up for lead changes.
22. **King** (Buckeye) - Ball or Rowel spurs, Reiner, smooth hand, do not drag. Keep him circling. Will look to change leads early.
23. **Lacey** (KCPH) Walk Jog only. Light Contact in face. No spur stop. Hold and say whoa. Pick up with a firm leg to turn
24. **Laredo** (Royal Creek) - PAINT GELDING – SWEET HORSE– RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
25. **Lizzy** - (M & M) - Weight Limit #160 VERY cranky with saddle changes. Please contact Shauna or Marissa to change her tack. All classes but reining and ranch horse. Best suited to walk trot. Pleasure typey but legs off to stop. Strong verbal cues. Appropriate spurs for the level. Sensitive but lazy.
26. **LJ-** (McColley) no spurs, light contact, use voice commands and leg beforehand.
27. **Lucky:** (Hancock) Bay QH mare. Great Draw easy quiet show horse. Set up for right lead. minimal contact is best will get upset if you have to much contact. Use seat to control speed. Ball spurs only if your division allows them.
28. **Macy** (Hancock) Bay QH, Good Draw. Light rein contact can hold don’t trap or over-bridle. Ride relaxed in seat and legs and she will be relaxed
29. **Melody** (EQD) - Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope. Two handed option
30. **Mia** (McColley) - Two handed option, spur trained. Squeeze to slow and stop. Ball spurs only but recommended no spurs, must tip her nose to the inside for her leads, use soft leg and hand cues and a lot of voice.
31. **Milo** (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.
32. **Nolan** (CNPH) - AQHA, Division appropriate Spur option, set up for canter, keep more contact at the canter.

33. **Ozzie** (Royal Creek) - Bay gelding QH – RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
34. **Raisin** (Hancock) Bay Quarter Horse Gelding. Good, easy draw. Ride with some contact. Squeeze to slow down. Will neck rein, but use legs to help guide him around. Can be lazy when asked to trot. Walk trot only. Can use crop if having lazy day.
35. **Rawhide** - (Timmermann's). Weight Limit #160 Walk trot horse. Loose reins, can be lazy so you may need to kick a little bit. No spurs or crop.
36. **Reis** (CNPB) - Fjord gelding, listens to voice will get bouncy if not kept slow.
37. **Remi** (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Use level appropriate spurs but do not overuse spur.
38. **Riley**- (EQD) Sorrel QH gelding- Old show horse. Been there, done that. Easy to ride. Does have a lead change so keep legs quiet when loping. Great draw.
39. **Rocky**- (McColley) spur trained (use leg and voice cues first, doesn't respond well at all to a heavy hand), LIGHT contact, has a lead change, division appropriate spurs
40. **Roxie** (CNPB) - Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160 Quarter Pony Mare, set up for canter, will get quick if not kept in the bridle. Good at jog. Division appropriate Spur option
41. **Ruby** (CNPB) - Gypsy Vanner Mare, Ride with contact, will get quick towards the gate. Division appropriate Spur option. Use voice.
42. **Sam** - (M & M) - all walk trot classes. Crop if necessary. Very easy. Will go super slow. Squeeze to stop and Back. Use strong verbal cues.
43. **Sarge** - (Circle M) Black and white paint, spurs should not be needed, but if they are then ball spurs only. Should be easy to ride. 2 hand option. Black and white paint, no spurs, should be easy to ride. 2 hand option.
44. **Sassy** (M & M) Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160 - very basic. Smooth gaits but goes better on a looser rein. If you try to slow and gather her she will get very upset. Two-handed option but goes ok one-handed. Do what's comfortable. The appropriate spur for the division. Crop if necessary for walk trot. Leg release to stop and strong verbal cues. Often takes the wrong lead to right. Break and ask again and she'll change easily.
45. **Squirt** (Timmermans) - Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160 Great Walk Trot horse. Loose reins, pretty responsive with your legs. No Spurs or crop.
46. **Tommy**- (EQD) Appaloosa Gelding. Ranch-style. Can be stubborn and/or lazy. Division appropriate Spurs. Maintain soft mouth contact. Set up for leads.
47. **Travis** - (Puthoff) Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160 - No or Dull Spur, moderate contact, light leg, use leg on circles, knows lead changes.
48. **Zip** - (Puthoff) Height Limit 5'9" Dull spur - lazy - moderate contact, good jogger, has a rough canter.

Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the right lead, run a large fast circle to the right, change leads at the center of the arena, run large fast circle to the left, and change leads at the center of the arena. (Figure 8)
6. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
7. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
8. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

1. **Hollywood** (Buckeye) - Ball or Rowel spurs, Reiner, Don't override. She may get strong
2. **Homer** (Buckeye) - ball or rowel spurs. Set up for leads. Help him in lead changes and keep forward motion. Steady down to stops with light hand.
3. **King** (Buckeye) - Ball or Rowel spurs, Reiner, smooth hand, do not drag. Keep him circling. Will look to change leads early.
4. **Jerl** -(Circle M) Reiner type, can be used in all divisions he is quiet enough just really bouncy jog. Spurs can be used, easy but can get forward in patterns if not controlled well
5. **Sarge** - (Circle M) Black and white paint, spurs should not be needed, but if they are then ball spurs only. Should be easy to ride. 2 hand option. Black and white paint, no spurs, should be easy to ride. 2 hand option.
6. **Nolan** (CNPH) - AQHA, Division appropriate Spur option, set up for canter, keep more contact at the canter.
7. **Reis** (CNPH) - Fjord gelding, listens to voice will get bouncy if not kept slow.
8. **Roxie** (CNPH) - **Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160** Quarter Pony Mare, set up for canter, will get quick if not kept in the bridle. Good at jog. Division appropriate Spur option
9. **Ruby** (CNPH) - Gypsy Vanner Mare, Ride with contact, will get quick towards the gate. Division appropriate Spur option. Use voice.
10. **Melody** (EQD) - Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope. Two handed option
11. **Riley**- (EQD) Sorrel QH gelding- Old show horse. Been there, done that. Easy to ride. Does have a lead change so keep legs quiet when loping. Great draw.
12. **Tommy**- (EQD) Appaloosa Gelding. Ranch-style. Can be stubborn and/or lazy. Division appropriate Spurs. Maintain soft mouth contact. Set up for leads.
13. **Andy** (Hancock) - Great draw! Does best if the rein is a little looser, stay out of his face. Ball spurs ok, easy to set up for leads.
14. **Arie**: (Hancock) ranch type will ride best with contact but do not trap. Level appropriate spurs.
15. **Chester** (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.
16. **Gator** (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.
17. **Izzy** (Hancock) ranch type let her have a little forward do not over bridle has lead change, may need ball spurs as the day unfolds. Please check with steward throughout the day.

18. **Lucky:** (Hancock) Bay QH mare. Great Draw easy quiet show horse. Set up for right lead. minimal contact is best will get upset if you have too much contact. Use seat to control speed. Ball spurs only if your division allows them.
19. **Macy** (Hancock) Bay QH, Good Draw. Light rein contact can hold don't trap or over-bridle. Ride relaxed in seat and legs and she will be relaxed
20. **Milo** (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.
21. **Raisin** (Hancock) Bay Quarter Horse Gelding. Good, easy draw. Ride with some contact. Squeeze to slow down. Will neck rein, but use legs to help guide him around. Can be lazy when asked to trot. Walk trot only. Can use crop if having lazy day.
22. **Remi** (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Use level appropriate spurs but do not overuse spur.
23. **Fred** (KCPH) **Weight Limit #160** Walk jog only. Has a spur stop. Can get lazy at times, just use legs and voice. Light hand contact. Has a weight limit as he is elderly.
24. **Lacey** (KCPH) Walk Jog only. Light Contact in face. No spur stop. Hold and say whoa. Pick up with a firm leg to turn
25. **Blue:** (Marcia) Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
26. **Charlie** (Marcia) - Light bit contact. Dull spurs. Two hand option.
27. **Grinder-** (Marcia) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
28. **Jess-**(Marcia) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
29. **Holli** (M & M) Appropriate Spurs for level. Feet out to stop (Reiner type) Can get anxious. Stay soft and quiet with her. Use verbal cues ("Whoa" to stop, "Easy" Or Hum to slow down.) Light rein contact. 2 handed option
30. **Lizzy - (M & M) - Weight Limit #160** VERY cranky with saddle changes. Please contact Shauna or Marissa to change her tack. All classes but reining and ranch horse. Best suited to walk trot. Pleasure typey but legs off to stop. Strong verbal cues. Appropriate spurs for the level. Sensitive but lazy.
31. **Sam - (M & M) -** all walk trot classes. Crop if necessary. Very easy. Will go super slow. Squeeze to stop and Back. Use strong verbal cues.
32. **Sassy** (M & M) **Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160** - very basic. Smooth gaits but goes better on a looser rein. If you try to slow and gather her she will get very upset. Two-handed option but goes ok one-handed. Do what's comfortable. The appropriate spur for the division. Crop if necessary for walk trot. Leg release to stop and strong verbal cues. Often takes the wrong lead to right. Break and ask again and she'll change easily.

33. **Cindi-** (McColley) No spurs, light contact, use voice commands first and very light leg aides.
34. **Joker-** (McColley) Medium contact, division appropriate spurs (he's kind of dull sided). Crop allowed, basic trained. Set up for lead changes.
35. **LJ-** (McColley) no spurs, light contact, use voice commands and leg beforehand.
36. **Mia** (McColley) - Two handed option, spur trained. Squeeze to slow and stop. Ball spurs only but recommended no spurs, must tip her nose to the inside for her leads, use soft leg and hand cues and a lot of voice.
37. **Rocky-** (McColley) spur trained (use leg and voice cues first, doesn't respond well at all to a heavy hand), LIGHT contact, has a lead change, division appropriate spurs
38. **Jess Too Temp** (National Champ) - division appropriate spurs. For walk trot use lots of leg! She takes a lot of leg, especially loping off on the right lead. A little bit of an attitude but pretty easy going.
39. **Dawg** - (Puthoff) **Height Limit 5'9"** Ball or no ball spur, small horse moderate contact, set up for leads - especially right use leg in corners or circles.
40. **Travis** - (Puthoff) **Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160** - No or Dull Spur, moderate contact, light leg, use leg on circles, knows lead changes.
41. **Zip** - (Puthoff) **Height Limit 5'9"** Dull spur - lazy - moderate contact, good jogger, has a rough canter.
42. **Jett** (Royal Creek) – BAY GELDING QH - RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
43. **Laredo** (Royal Creek) - PAINT GELDING – SWEET HORSE– RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE

45. **Big Shot** - (Timmermann's). Nice easy-going horse. Spring-loaded jog more contact with the reins and set him up for his leads. Big easy looper, soft legs for cues. No spurs or crop.
46. **Henry** - (Timmermann's) Ranch horse. Spring loaded jog, smooth lope likes leg contact needs to be reminded to collect but good mannered. Spins and does flying lead changes. No spurs.
47. **Rawhide** - (Timmermann's). **Weight Limit #160** Walk trot horse. Loose reins, can be lazy so you may need to kick a little bit. No spurs or crop.
48. **Squirt** (Timmermans) - **Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160** Great Walk Trot horse. Loose reins, pretty responsive with your legs. No Spurs or crop.
