


*** Salutary Neglect ***

- Interactions between American Indians and Europeans (link)
 - Three Gs: Gold, God, and Glory

- #1 interaction leads to incredible death rate of American Indians due to disease. (smallpox)

 - caste system
- English
 - Initially friendly and then unfriendly over land
 - Metacom or King Philip's War
- French
 - Fur Trade with limited European settlement
