

Son Heung-min, who started hunting for points in the new season by writing a hat trick, showed a special responsibility as the team's captain.

Son Heung-min said in a local interview after an away match against Burnley in the fourth round of the Premier League (EPL) at Turf Moore in Burnley, England. We started with a pushback, but we fought back strongly.

In this game, Son Heung-min scored in the 16th minute of the first half, 18th minute of the second half, and 21st minute of the second half, leading the team's 5-2 victory and 4 league unbeaten (3 wins and 1 draw) march.
