Guide for Rising 11th Grade Registration (Current Sophomores)

Sophomore Advisors,

During Advisory on **February 11-14, 2025**, we will be distributing physical and digital registration materials to our students.

Step 1: The Course Fair is on February 11 & 12

- ❖ During this time students will be given a <u>Course Selection Worksheet</u>. This should be used to take notes and keep track of classes during the course fair.
- ❖ See Course Fair Plan shared from Mrs. Hoglund.

Step 2: Preparing for Registration - February 13

- Briefly review graduation requirements with students (found in the <u>Programs of Study</u> on page 9)
- Remind all students that they will most likely need the following courses:
 - ➤ English 11 CP, AP Language & Composition, or English Composition 1 DE
 - ➤ U.S. History or AP U.S. History
 - > Their next math sequence (Geometry, Algebra II, Intro to Precalculus, Precalculus SDC, or Statistics SDC)
 - > The next science sequence (Biology, if they haven't taken yet, or Chemistry)
 - Encourage students to sign up for a Fine Art if they have not taken one yet: Band, Chorus, Visual Art, Theatre, Digital Arts 1, or Help Desk
 - > Encourage students to continue courses for their Elective Focus (see Programs of Study for prerequisites and course sequences)
 - ➤ If a student has not taken Spanish I & II or French I & II or they have not turned in a World Language Waiver then they will need to sign up for those courses or see Mr. Royston for the required form.
- ❖ Connect to Mr. Royston's Live Google Chat for Q&A
- ❖ Current 10th grade students did not create 6-year plans with their counselor last year so they will not have these.

Step 3: Registration - February 14 & 15

- Direct students to open a new tab and log in to Skyward for future scheduling.

- Students should use <u>Course Selection Worksheet</u>, <u>Programs of Study</u>, <u>Junior Elective Options Slideshow</u>, and <u>Dual Enrollment</u>, and <u>AP Access Flyer</u> to guide them through selecting courses.
- ❖ Students can download/save their Skyward Course Request List to share with parents by selecting print, then setting the printer to Save as PDF.
