

What is S4 and how to find it (video)

S4 is the California State University system's web database that provides a user-friendly interface to manage experiential learning opportunities for university students.

Cal Poly Humboldt's students use S4 to report their off-campus placements for their service learning classes, academic internships, student teaching, and professional practicum placements.

Logging into \$4

To log into S4, navigate to your **myHumboldt** portal at https://my.humboldt.edu/ and log in using your Cal Poly Humboldt username and password. Once you are logged in, select the **Quick Links** dropdown menu at the top of the page.



Then scroll down the list of available links until you see **S4 (Community Placements)** link and select it.




Alternatively, use the following <u>S4 login link</u>.

Depending on the computer you are using, you may be directed to the S4 login page, or you may be logged in directly into S4.

If you are directed to the S4 login page, select the **Student/Faculty Log In** button in the upper right corner.

Next, from the campus dropdown menu, select your campus: **Cal Poly Humboldt**. Then, once more, select the **Log In** button.



Now you will be directed to the S4 application's Dashboard, where you can report your community placement, fill out forms related to it, and log the hours you spent in your placement.
