The Dynamic Learning Project Coaching Fellow is a **full-time position** focused on providing teachers with the support to enable powerful use of technology in the classroom. The coaching structure is based on helping teachers and their students tackle challenges by implementing innovative, tech-based strategies.


### **Key Responsibilities**

- Provide direct support for teachers to address challenges through use of innovative strategies and tools.
- Participate in ongoing professional learning opportunities that improve their ability to support teachers.
- Involve the broader school community in the program by sharing educational technology resources
- Provide feedback and insights that support the Dynamic Learning Project program design and research

### **Daily Schedule**

Each day will be different. The Coaching Fellow will optimize their daily schedule to accommodate:

- Developing program content
- Meetings with mentor, principal and teachers
- Teacher classroom visits, based on the challenge/strategy innovation plans



## 8 Week Cycles

The program is designed in four 8-week coaching cycles that happen throughout the school year. There is also a regional Winter Institute midway through the year. Here is a robust list of tasks that the Coaching Fellow will be completing during cycle 1.

- Communicate with other curriculum, instruction, coaching professionals about the Coaching Fellow's unique role
- Invite the Coaching Fellow to join district coaching events / PD

- Support the work of the Coaching Fellow, which includes meeting with him/her on a biweekly basis
