INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIAL MEDICAL TREATMENT (Please identify for whom these instructions apply):	

### Homecoming is a school-sponsored activity and all school rules and regulations will be in effect.

In particular, your attention is called to the Glendale Unified School District's policy on possession/use/influence of alcohol, drugs or any controlled substances. Stated simply:

Any student who has unlawfully possessed, used, sold or otherwise furnished or been under the influence of any controlled substance as defined in Section 11032 of the Health and Safety Code, alcoholic beverage or intoxicant of any kind at school or any school sponsored activity shall be subject to:

- 1. An immediate five (5) day out-of-school suspension;
- 2. Possible arrest by law enforcement authorities;
- 3. Possible expulsion from all schools in the District;
- 4. Possible transfer to another school or educational program;
- 5. Possible denial of the privilege of participation in graduation ceremonies and/or extracurricular activities.

All dress code policies remain in effect. No bare midriffs, inappropriate/ revealing items, or clothing with inappropriate graphics will be allowed. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE EVENT IF THEY ARE INAPPROPRIATELY DRESSED. No refunds will be issued for students removed for dress code violations.

All students and guests will submit to a light pat-down and purse check upon arrival. The following items will be confiscated:

Containers with a screw-on cap or lid including: perfume, lip gloss, eyeliner, lip liner, lipstick and cologne bottles.

#### Confiscated items will be held in the AP Office for one week after the event.
