What we can do:

- Review exemplars with you
- Help you break down the questions/prompts
- Help you break down the rubrics & apply them to your writing
- Ask you questions to help you develop your ideas and analyze your evidence
- Point out areas of confusion and potential strategies to improve clarity/completeness

What we can't do:

- Make direct edits or revisions
- Suggest alternative wording/phrasing
- Evaluate/score sections
- Tell you how to answer the prompts or what to write in the document

Note: All students are limited to average one visit a week for TPA-related support (up to 16 visits a semester)
