What doubts do you currently have about your faith? Write them down honestly, without filter:
God is a compassionate, caring, and understanding. He doesn't condemn us for having doubts, but instead He uses our doubts to draw us closer to Him. Take a moment to jot down an honest prayer to God, inviting Him into your doubts and process:

Now, take a few minutes to just ask God what He wants to say to you right now. And just listen. Then jot down what comes to mind. Don't overthink it:





If you're doubting with faith yourself:

- 1. **Reach out to a safe, trusted person** and share honestly about what you're going through. Ask for prayer, or just a listening ear. *We're not meant to go through life's struggles alone.*
- 2. **Journal:** Keep a record of your doubts, questions, thoughts, and prayers about your faith. This can help you better process, reflect, talk with (and listen to) God, and get more clarity.
- 3. **Explore resources** that address doubts and questions about faith, whether it's books, podcasts, or articles. *You can find some we recommend below.*

If you know someone doubting their faith:

Reach out to just sit with and offer a listening ear to someone you know who's navigating their doubts in faith. Remember: understanding and support are often more valuable than providing immediate answers.
