Payment Process

Cohasset Learning Studio uses [Sawyer](#), an online software, for all billing and scheduling. Once a tutoring plan has been created for your child, you will receive an email containing a link to set up your payments on Sawyer.

Families will be billed on a 10 month cycle (September to June). Your total payment will be spread evenly over 10 months, even though some months will have fewer lessons than others. You are not charged for any holidays or vacation weeks marked on the studio calendar. Your first monthly payment will be taken the day your child is registered on Sawyer.

Lesson Absences - School Year Only (Sept-June)

Families must provide 24 hours notice for lesson cancellations in order to qualify for a refund. Same day cancellations are not refunded. Most tutors can not offer make-up lessons so it is best to keep to the agreed upon schedule each week.

Note: There are no refunds for missing a small group class lesson.

Private Lessons:

- 2 refunded pre-scheduled cancellations during the fall semester (Sept.-Jan.)
- 2 refunded pre-scheduled cancellations during the spring semester (Feb.-June)

Semi-Private Lessons:

- Refunds are not given when 1 student misses a semi-private lesson, even when advanced notice is given
- Refunds are only given when both students have agreed to and pre-scheduled a lesson cancellation

Families ARE refunded for:

- Tutor-initiated cancellation
- Unexpected cancellations such as town power-outages and snow days .

Tutoring Cancellation Process

Although we are registering your child for a full year of lessons, you may end your tutoring plan at any time throughout the year. *You must provide two-weeks notice.* If you choose to cancel your tutoring plan, you will only be charged for the lessons that your child has had, including the lessons scheduled during the 2-weeks notice. Scheduled auto-payments for future lessons will be canceled.

Summer Billing and Absences

During the summer session, billing is set up differently. Families will agree on a specified number of lessons and will be billed that exact number.

For example:

- 8 lessons x 45 minutes
- 5 lessons x 60 minutes
- 6 lessons x 60 minutes

There are no refunds for canceled summer lessons. If you are unable to attend a lesson, let your tutor know as soon as possible out of respect for her schedule. Although she might not be able to offer make-ups that work for your schedule, we will always try to make it work.

Weekly updates, Progress Monitoring, and Progress Reports

You will receive a *weekly update* from your tutor. This brief update will provide the following information:

- This week we learned about / practiced / read:

You will also receive a seasonal *progress monitoring update* from your tutor in January and June. This progress report will contain:

- progress monitoring scores from the semester
- a list of skills taught during the semester



You may request an additional *progress report* from your tutor at any point throughout the year at an additional cost. You may request two progress reports per year. A full progress report includes a list of skills taught, description of strengths, description weaknesses/error patterns, light assessment and analysis. Parents often find progress reports valuable when preparing for an IEP meeting. As writing a progress report takes time, please allow your child's tutor two weeks to complete and return the report.
