In performing their duties, The International Association for Creation's staff, board members, volunteers, and consultants are privy to information about individuals and families, such as giving history, assets, wealth, and family relationships. This is especially true for staff, board members, volunteers, and consultants involved in fundraising and development activities.

Due to the sensitivity of this information, it is important that all The International Association for Creation's staff, board members, volunteers, and consultants adhere to the policy that information shared with them remains confidential, is not discussed with others in private or public setting and is not disclosed or used for any other purposes.
